SR 93/I-75 FROM SR-822/SHERIDAN STREET TO SR 818/GRIFFIN ROAD IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information for the SR 93/I-75 from SR 822/ Sheridan Street to SR 818/Griffin Road Improvements Project in the Town of Davie, Town of Southwest Ranches, City of Pembroke Pines, and City of Cooper City.

Construction Cost: \$12.6 million

Construction Start: April 2023

Estimated Completion: Late 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Roadway widening to provide continuous auxiliary lanes and 10' shoulders in each direction of SR-93/I-75 within project limits
- Repaving and restriping along SR-93/I-75 within project limits
- Replacing overhead signage
- Installing new guardrail within project limits
- Updating lighting and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS)

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures on SR-93/I-75 are permitted nightly, 8:30 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. To ensure motorist safety, access to the Managed Lanes may be restricted during these closures.
- SR 93/I-75 entrance and exit ramp closures are permitted nightly, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
