





Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program




- Broward MPO competitive grant program that provides funding opportunities for small local transportation projects which improve the safety and mobility for all transportation users in Broward County.
- The program can fund projects such as (but not limited to): complete streets projects, traffic calming and intersection improvements, ADA upgrades, mobility hubs, bus shelters, bike racks and technology advancements such as transit signal priority and traffic control devices
- Applicants are required to submit "program ready" projects with proof of roadway ownership, well defined scope of work, partner collaboration, cost estimate, documentation of public outreach and resolution of support.
- The following project was submitted by the City of Weston (2015) and awarded funding:
 - Weston Road Mobility Project. (FM No. 439994-1)

Project Limits Indian Trace to State Road 84



Project Overview

Objective:

- 1. Improve the safety of users of all modes of transportation
- 2. Address gaps in the Bicycle Infrastructure Network

Background:

- City of Weston has been designated as a Bicycle Friendly Community
- The City of Weston 2013 Bicycle Master Plan identified Weston Road as a candidate for adding bicycle lanes within the city limits
- Coordination with the City of Sunrise lead to extending the bicycle lanes along
 Weston Road to SR-84 to close the gap

Project Overview

Background (cont'd):

- This is a mobility project funded by Broward County MPO
- Multiple projects in the area are being planned/designed to provide a wellconnected bicycle network:
 - Project 438117-1 is constructing improvements along SR-84 between Glades Parkway and Weston Road
 - Future Surtax Project WEST 303 may extend bicycle lanes along Weston Road to Griffin Road

Project Overview

Proposed Improvements:

- Provide bicycle lanes by widening and repaving the existing roadway (NB and SB)
- Add green colored markings in the bike lanes to increase driver awareness at conflict points
- Replace deficient ADA pedestrian ramps
- Install guardrail to shield unprotected hazards
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings
- Pedestrian Signal Improvements

Project Length: 1.6 miles

Installation of 5' to 8' Bicycle Lanes

- Proposed buffered bike lanes along a segment of Weston Rd NB
- Intermittent green-colored pavement to increase driver awareness at conflict points
- No right-of-way will be required






Existing Roadway Typical Section




Proposed Roadway Typical Section

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in three phases to reduce the impacts of construction in the community
- Road will remain open, single lane closures (per direction) are anticipated
 - Lane closures not permitted during peak hours
- Paving activities will be performed at night
 - Sunday to Thursday
- Driveways to properties and street access will always be maintained during construction
- Bus stop closures shall be minimized

Final Design Completion: August 2021

Letting: December 2021

Estimated Construction Start: Spring 2022

Estimated Completion: Spring 2023




