### State Road (SR) 7/US 441 Corridor Improvements Project (Group 8)

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 7/US 441 Transit Corridor Improvements Project (Group 8) along SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from SR 824/Pembroke Road to SW 9<sup>th</sup> Street in the City of Pembroke Pines; and SW 25<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SR 7/US 441 & SW 33<sup>rd</sup> Street from SW 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to SR7/US 441 in the City of Miramar. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

The cities of Pembroke Pines and Miramar, as the Project Sponsors, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT District Four design and construct the SR 7/US 441 Transit Corridor Improvements project through the City of Pembroke Pines Resolution No. 2015-R-45 and through the City of Miramar Resolution No. 20-162. The Broward MPO is investing over \$300 million to create safer, healthier communities in Broward County and this project is one of many within a larger plan to create enhanced bicycle, pedestrian, and public transportation access. The Broward MPO is a federally mandated agency that is responsible for making decisions on local transportation issues and deciding how to spend federal funds on transportation projects within Broward County. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities. #### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

##### SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue from SR 824/Pembroke Road to SW 9<sup>th</sup> Street

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience
- Minor roadway widening throughout project limits to accommodate 5-foot bike lanes
- Removing necessary foliage to construct a continuous concrete sidewalk throughout the corridor to enhance safety and connectivity for pedestrians
- Upgrading curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and accessibility

##### SW 25<sup>th</sup> Street from SW 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SR 7/US 441

- Removing necessary foliage to construct a continuous concrete sidewalk throughout the corridor to enhance safety and connectivity for pedestrians
- Upgrading curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and accessibility
- Constructing a new bus shelter at SR 7/US 441 and SW 25<sup>th</sup> Street

##### SW 33<sup>rd</sup> Street from SW 62<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to SR 7/US 441

- Removing necessary foliage to construct a continuous concrete sidewalk throughout the corridor to enhance safety and connectivity for pedestrians
- Upgrading curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and accessibility

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures along SW 72<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, SW 25<sup>th</sup> Street, and SW 33<sup>rd</sup> Street are permitted 9:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., weekdays
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
