PROJECT PURPOSE

To improve safety and serviceability of multi-use pathway along canal C-9

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Reconstruct and redesign of existing pathway
- Install guardrail at each intersecting road for increased pedestrian and automobile safety
- Replace damaged light poles

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the inconvenience to the community.
- Lane closures will occur one lane at a time during non-peak hours to minimize impacts on traffic.
- No full roadway closures are anticipated.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times.
- No detours necessary

- Anticipated Completion: **Fall 2026**
- Estimated Construction Cost: **\$981,365.00**

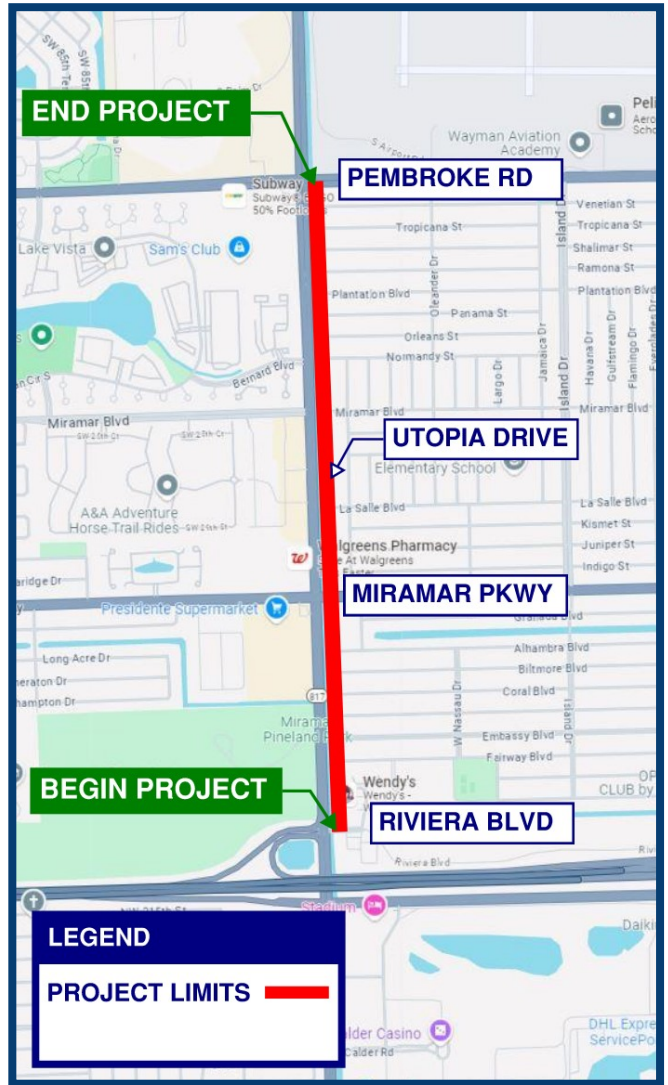
