The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Public Meeting regarding the proposed improvements along SR 824/Pembroke Road from east of Oleander Drive to east of South 61st Avenue in Broward County, Florida. The Public Meeting will be held in two formats: virtual (online) and in-person, simultaneously, and will include a presentation and an open discussion. Attendees can ask questions and/or make comments via the chat function or in-person.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurface and restripe roadway pavement
- Upgrade curb ramps to meet current standards
- Upgrade signs and pavement markings
- Upgrade existing signals at intersections
- Upgrade signalized intersection lighting with Light Emitting Diode (LED) luminaires
- Minor drainage improvements

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Temporary lane closures will be done during non-peak hours on non-event days
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
