Complete Streets and Other Localized Initiatives Program



- Broward MPO competitive grant program that provides funding opportunities for small local transportation projects which improve the safety and mobility for all transportation users in Broward County.
- The program can fund projects such as (but not limited to): complete streets projects, traffic
 calming and intersection improvements, ADA upgrades, mobility hubs, bus shelters, bike racks
 and technology advancements such as transit signal priority and traffic control devices
- Applicants are required to submit "program ready" projects with proof of roadway ownership, well defined scope of work, partner collaboration, cost estimate, documentation of public outreach and resolution of support.



Segment 1: N. Dixie Highway to NE 13th Avenue Segment 2: NE 18th Avenue to SR 5/US-1/Federal Highway




- Sidewalk is discontinuous and lacks continuity within the project limits
- Existing Sidewalk limits:
 - E. of Dixie Highway to NE 44th Place (240-feet)
 - E. of NE 11th Avenue to E. of FEC RR Tracks (north side only) (98-feet)
 - E. of FEC RR Tracks to NE 12th Terrace (south side) (325-feet)
 - E. of FEC RR Tracks (near Orion) to NE 18th Avenue (north side) (2800-feet)

• E. of Dixie Highway to NE 44th Place (240')





• E. of NE 11th Avenue to E. of FEC RR Tracks (north side only) (98-feet)





• E. of FEC RR Tracks to NE 12th Terrace (south side) (325-feet)





• E. of FEC RR Tracks (near Orion) to NE 18th Avenue (north side) (2800')





Proposed Improvements


Proposed Improvements

- Construct sidewalks along both sides of the roadway where missing, from N. Dixie Highway to NE 13th Avenue and from NE 18th Avenue to SR 5/US 1/Federal Highway
- Repave roadway where new sidewalk is being constructed
- Include curb ramps and detector warning pads in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Modify drainage to accommodate sidewalk
- Signing and pavement markings
- Improve pedestrian signalization and lighting at the intersection of SR 5/US 1

Project Length: Approximately 1 mile



FLORANADA ROAD (NE 45TH STREET) FROM NE 44 PLACE TO WEST OF FEC RAILROAD TRACKS





- Repave roadway

Residential Area Impacts

Area: E. of NE 18th Avenue to NE 20th Avenue

- Sidewalk construction
- Repave roadway


Access maintained at all times to businesses and residences

Construction Impacts


- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community






FLORANADA ROAD (NE 45TH STREET) BETWEEN NE 19 TERRACE AND SR 5 (US-1)


FLORANADA ROAD (NE 45TH STREET) FROM EAST OF FEC

FROM NE 18 AVENUE TO NE 19 TERRACE




FLORANADA ROAD (NE 45TH STREET) BETWEEN N 19 TERRACE AND SR 5 (US-1)


COMPLETE REPAVING OF SEGMENT 1 (WEST OF FEC RR)




