


NW 29TH STREET TO CLOSE TUESDAY, AUGUST 27 THROUGH THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 13, 2024

NW 29th Street between NW 3rd Avenue and SR 811/N Andrews Avenue, will be closed around-the-clock for speed table construction, beginning 9 a.m., Tuesday, Aug. 27 through 5:30 p.m., Thursday, Aug. 29, and Sep. 13 will be used as contingency day if needed.

Traffic will be detoured via NW 29th Street, SR 845/Powerline Road, SR 816/W Oakland Park Boulevard, SR 811/N Andrews Avenue, and NW 25th Street. Access to local roads and residential properties will be maintained at all times. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

Safety is the Department's top priority and is embedded in all that we do. Speed tables act as artificial speed bumps, forcing drivers to slow down significantly. This reduction in speed helps prevent accidents and injuries, particularly for pedestrians and



PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

Project improvements include installing additional speed tables on NW 29th Street from NW 3rd to SR 811/N Andrews Avenue, widening the roadway to accommodate 4-foot bicycle lanes in each direction, constructing new sidewalks along the south side of the corridor, upgrading pedestrian crosswalks to countdown timers at N. Andrews Avenue, milling and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits, and replacing the decorative stamped concrete at the intersections of NW 7th Avenue, NW 6th Avenue, and NW 3rd Avenue.
