LOXAHATCHEE ROAD MOBILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT MONTHLY PROGRESS REPORT— SEPTEMBER 2024

The City of Parkland, as the Project Sponsor, received funding through the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) and requested that FDOT design and construct the Loxahatchee Road Mobility Improvements Project through the City of Parkland Resolution Numbers 2016-510, 2021-011, and 2021-018.

The following update provides information on the construction segment of Loxahatchee Road between SR 817/N University Drive and Parkside Drive.

ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES BETWEEN SR 817/N UNIVERSITY DRIVE AND PARKSIDE DRIVE

- Complete drainage structures and pipe connections east of SR 817/N University Drive
- Continue with gravity wall installation
- Continue with coping (protective cap) installation at sheet pile locations
- Continue with the eastbound roadway construction west of Parkside Drive
- Continue with curb & gutter and sidewalk installation
- Continue with milling, resurfacing, and roadway widening on the westbound lane
- Commence guardrail removal and installation
- FP&L to continue with utility relocation efforts and adjustments

CURRENT MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC (MOT)

- To ensure community and crew safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, Loxahatchee Road from SR 817/N University Drive to Parkside Drive is closed through Fall 2024. Traffic will be detoured via SR 817/N University Drive, Holmberg Road, and Parkside Drive. Local access will be maintained. [Please click here to view the detour flyer.](#)
