SR-7/US-441 MULTIMODAL IMPROVEMENTS CORRIDOR STUDY

Study was completed and adopted by the MPO Board in July 2016.

The study area is a mile-wide corridor centered on SR-7/US-441 that runs from just south of the Miami-Dade County Line to north of Sample Road.

The following goals were identified:

- Improve safety for all users
- Improve transit service within the SR-7/US-441 corridor
- Invest in transportation solutions that are cost-effective
- Encourage land use and urban form to support multimodal transportation options
- Reduce automobile traffic congestion, without impacting the mobility and/or safety of cyclists, pedestrians, and transit users adversely

Eight (8) groups of projects have moved to implementation.

• Project Length: 2.002 miles




Proposed Improvements

- Orange Drive
 - Sidewalk construction along the north side of Orange Drive from Florida's Turnpike to SR 7/US 441
 - Minor Drainage improvements
- Taft Street
 - Construction of a Shared Use Path along the north side of Taft Street from SR 7/US 441 to N. 40th Avenue
 - Installation of new light poles behind Shared Use Path
 - Drainage improvements will be placed beneath the Shared Use Path




Orange Drive Existing Typical Section


Orange Drive Proposed Typical Section


Taft Street Existing Typical Section




































Landscape / Irrigation Impacts & Tree Saving Strategies

- All impacted irrigation systems will be fixed
- Most of the trees that are being removed will be re-installed by the City after the project is constructed
- Some of the trees will remain as-is
- At four locations, shared use path will be raised to protect the roots of the trees
- Shared use path will be split at two locations to maintain the existing tree in place
- License agreements for certain properties will be requested to allow the contractor to properly harmonize



Construction Impacts




Construction Impacts


- Work will be done in phases to reduce the impacts of construction in the community
- The existing number of lanes will be maintained during peak hours on Orange Drive
- Lane closures are only permitted during off-peak along Taft Street
- Pedestrian detours will be provided to maintain connectivity throughout corridor including access to Hollywood Hills Elementary School
- Access to all properties along Orange Drive and Taft Street will be maintained


Phase 1

Daytime work under flagging lacksquareoperation to build path, drainage, lighting, and signage improvements.

Close WB left turn lane to construct overbuild, widening, drainage and driveways


Phase 3

 Close EB & WB Left turn lanes to construct widening at 58th, 56th, 50th and 46th Avenue Intersections

Phase 1

 North sidewalk closures will route pedestrians one block to the north

Phase 3

 North sidewalk closure between SR 7 and N 59th Ct. will detour pedestrians to the south sidewalk using existing crosswalks at SR 7 and N 56th Avenue

Estimated Construction Cost: \$3.2 million


