Purpose: Routine Preventative Maintenance

Project Length: 351 feet

Project Limits: State Road (SR) 844 / 14th Street Causeway over the Intracoastal Waterway

Project Duration: 168 days (plus holidays and weather days)

Bridge Closure: Total of four weekends

Construction Begins: October 7, 2021

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2022

Construction Cost: \$1.07 million

Contractor: Seminole Equipment, Inc.

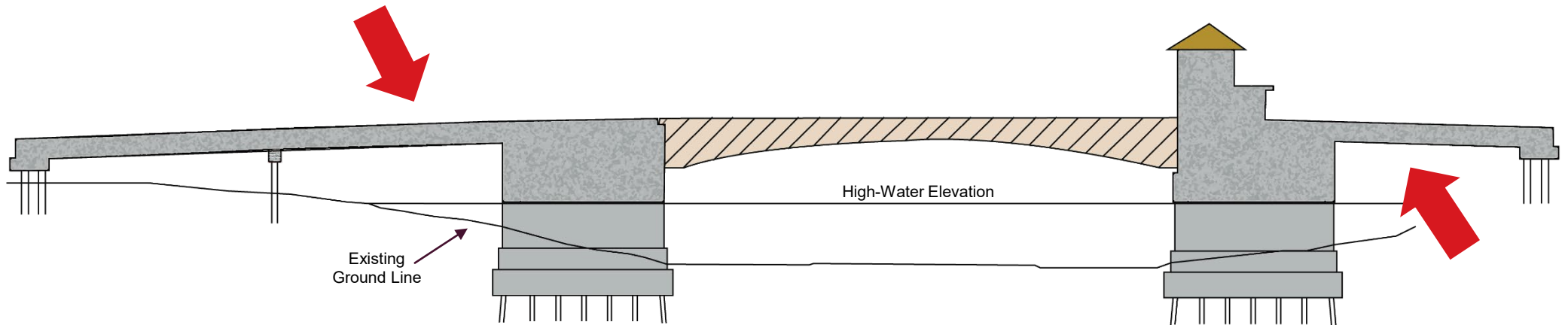
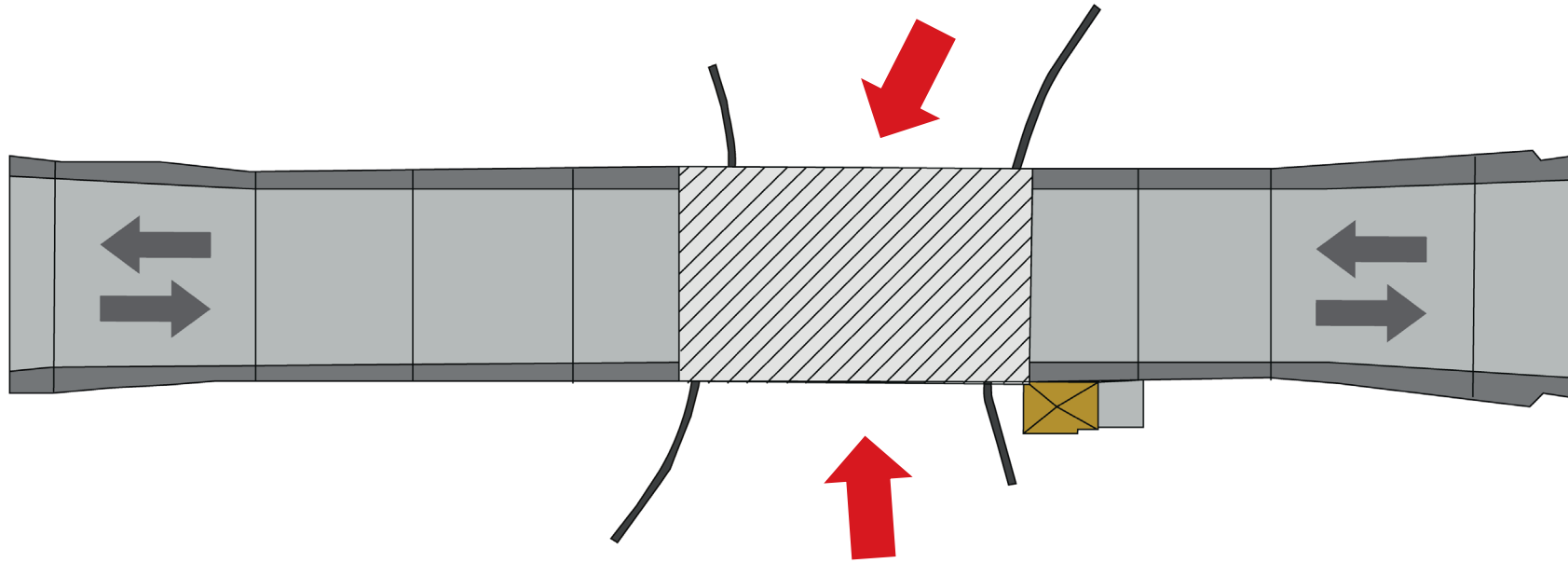


Project Improvements

- Pressure washing and painting the structural steel of the SR 844 / 14th Street Causeway bascule bridge (Bridge No. 860060) over the Intracoastal Waterway
- Pressure washing and painting the concrete portions of the bridge
- Refurbishing the span locks and other mechanical components of the bridge
- Painting the sidewalk and traffic railing

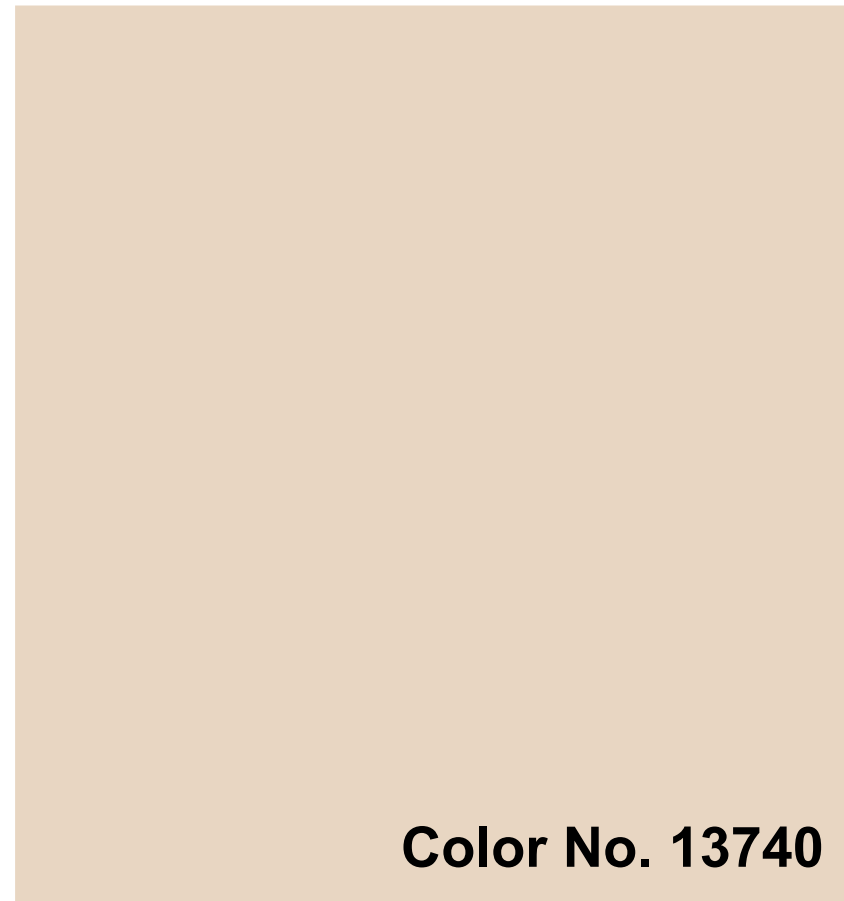


Areas To Be Painted



Proposed Bridge Color

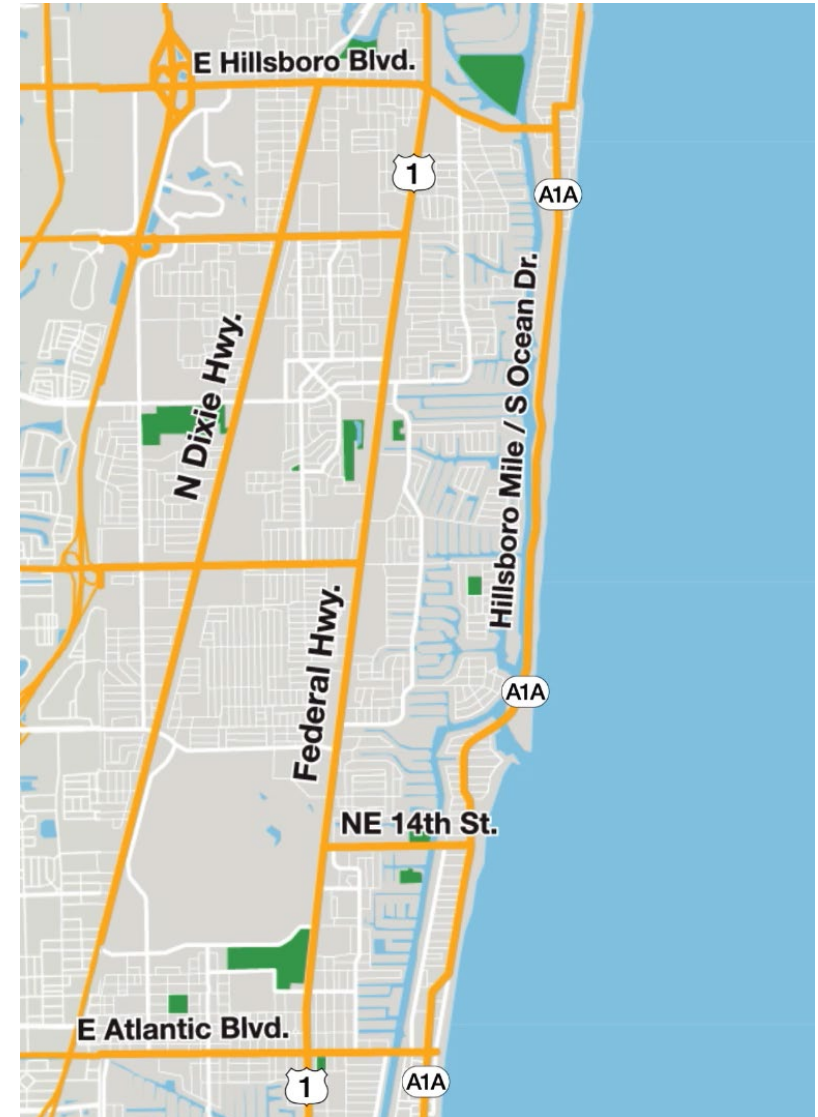
State Road (SR) 844 / 14th Street Causeway Final Color will be Federal Color Standard 595B - No. 13740. See below for example.

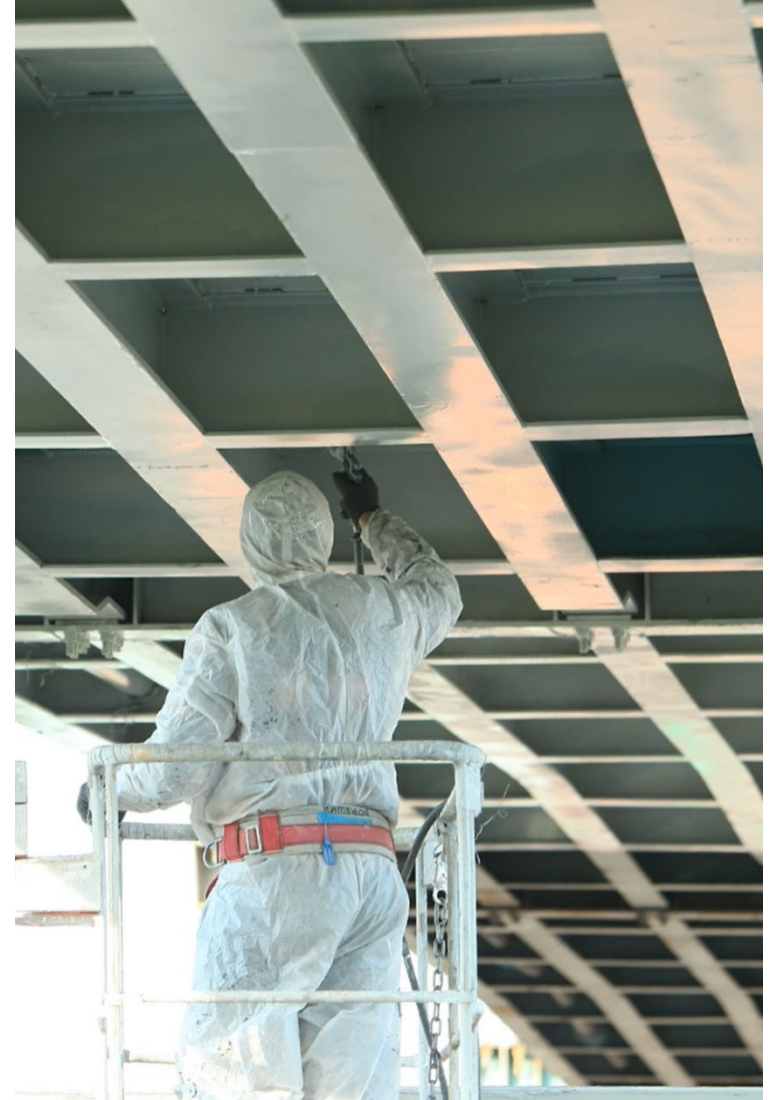
Traffic Impacts

- One lane in each direction may be closed at any time Sunday through Saturday.
- Full bridge closures for vehicle and pedestrian traffic will occur from 11 p.m. Friday to 8 a.m. Monday for a total of four weekends. Traffic will be detoured to SR 814 / Atlantic Boulevard and SR 810 / Hillsboro Boulevard.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
- Access to the Alsdorf Park Public Boat Launch and other community resources will be maintained.
- Marine traffic will be maintained through the navigable waterway. Channel restrictions may occur and will be published in the U.S. Coast Guard's Local Notice to Mariners.



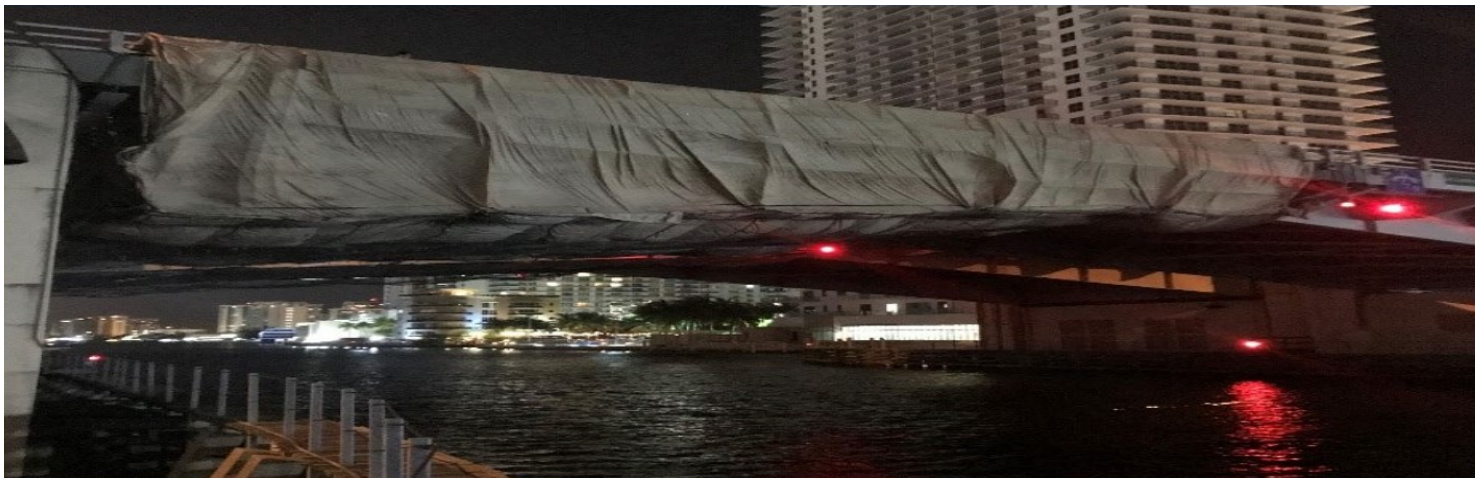
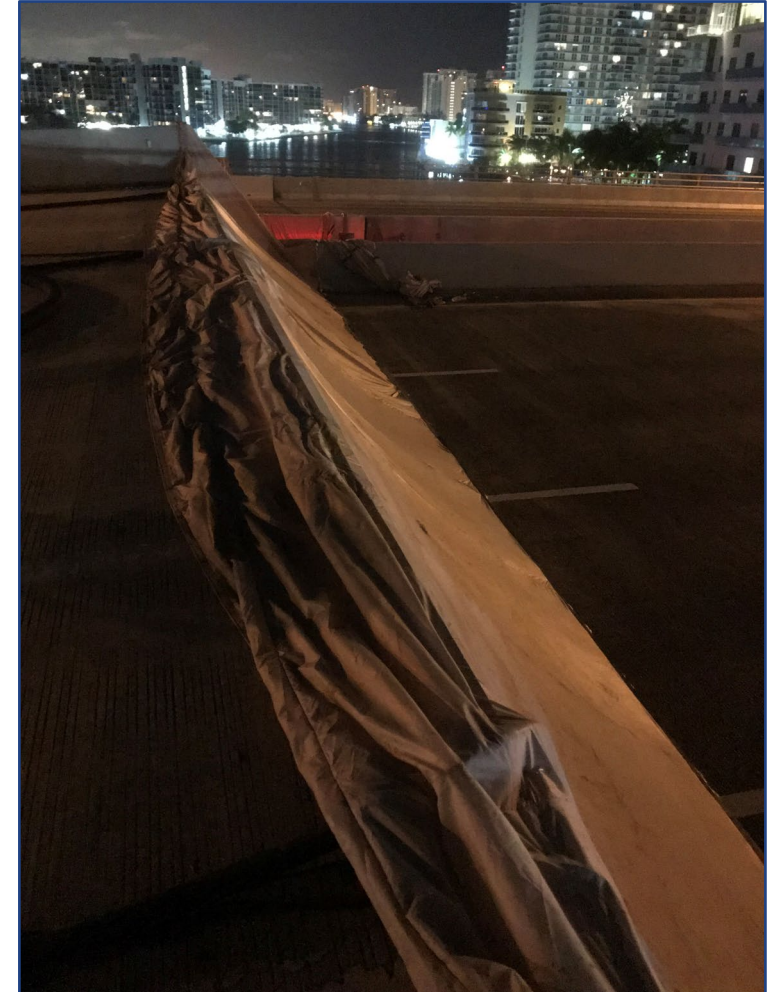
What to Expect

- Detour and work zone signage will be installed east and west of the bridge work zone.
- Complete seal of work zone (above and below bridge deck)
- Safe and controlled work area prevents paint materials and dust from entering the air
- Aids in noise control

Dust Control & Air Quality Monitoring

- Monitoring occurs when an operation is likely to produce dust
- Measure dust levels in surrounding air to ensure that they are kept within the acceptable levels (US EPA 40 CFR 50)
- Monitors are placed in strategic locations that are most sensitive to dust and downwind of the painting operation to ensure emissions are properly controlled



Community Outreach

- The Community Outreach Specialist will distribute project update flyers via email and door-to-door as needed.
- Traffic impacts will be included in the FDOT District Four Communications Manager's Weekly Traffic Impact Press Release.
- The project team will meet with city/county officials, community groups and property owners regarding project updates as needed.

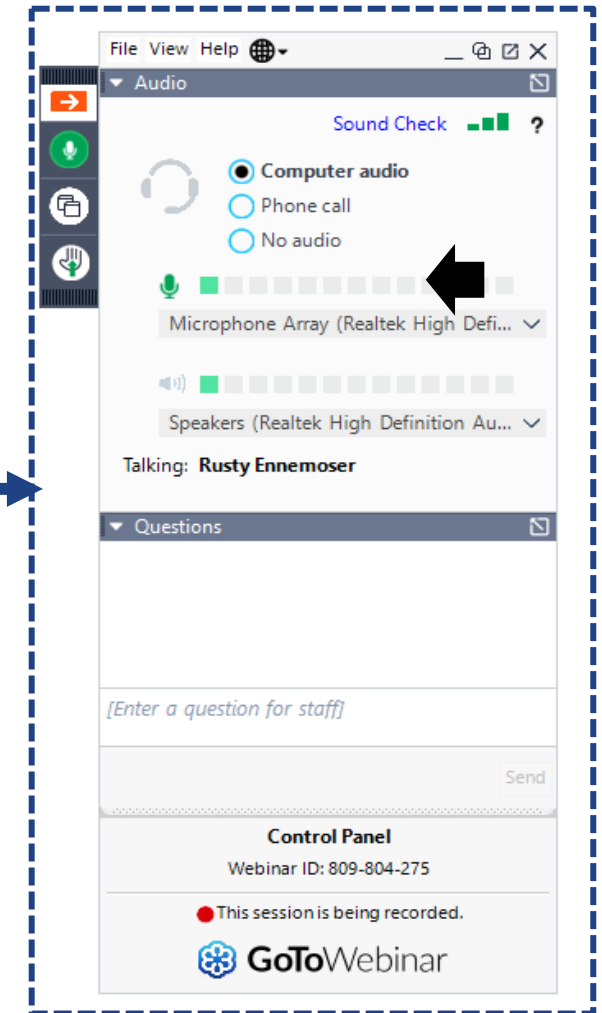

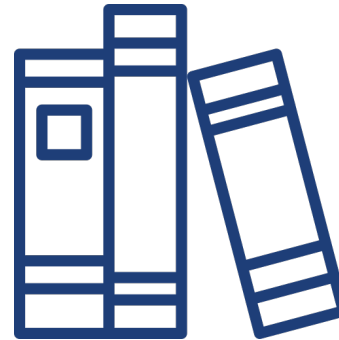

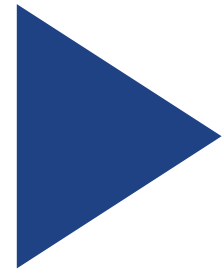
