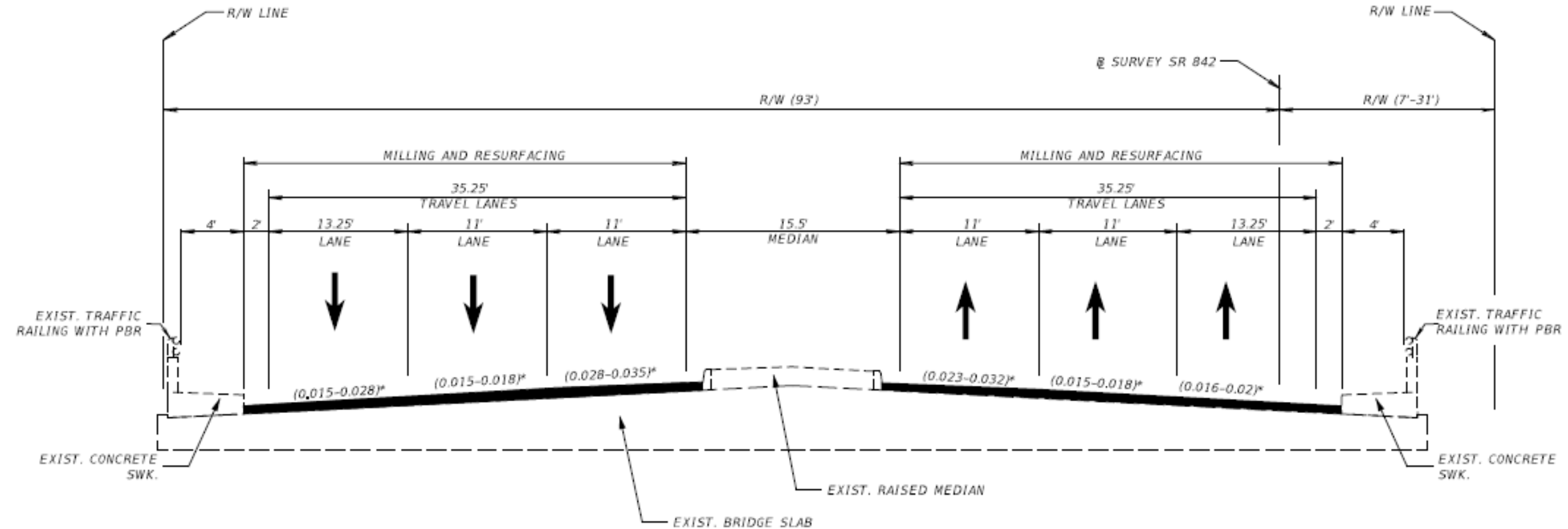
Proposed Improvements

- Resurface the existing travel lanes
- Reconstruct sub-standard pedestrian curb ramps
- Reconstruct damaged sidewalk
- Adjust storm drain manhole tops
- Close five driveways at four properties that are not in use:
6301, 5521 & 5541 W. Broward Blvd., and 1 SW 59 Ave.
- Replace all deficient ground mounted signs
- Replace all pavement markings
- Replace all pedestrian detectors (pushbuttons)
- Replace damaged traffic signal poles on southeast corner of SW 59 Avenue
- Replace in-ground sensors for the two traffic monitoring sites
- Inlet top replacements and pipe lining along the eastbound lane adjacent to the canal
- Improve lighting to LED at six signalized intersections

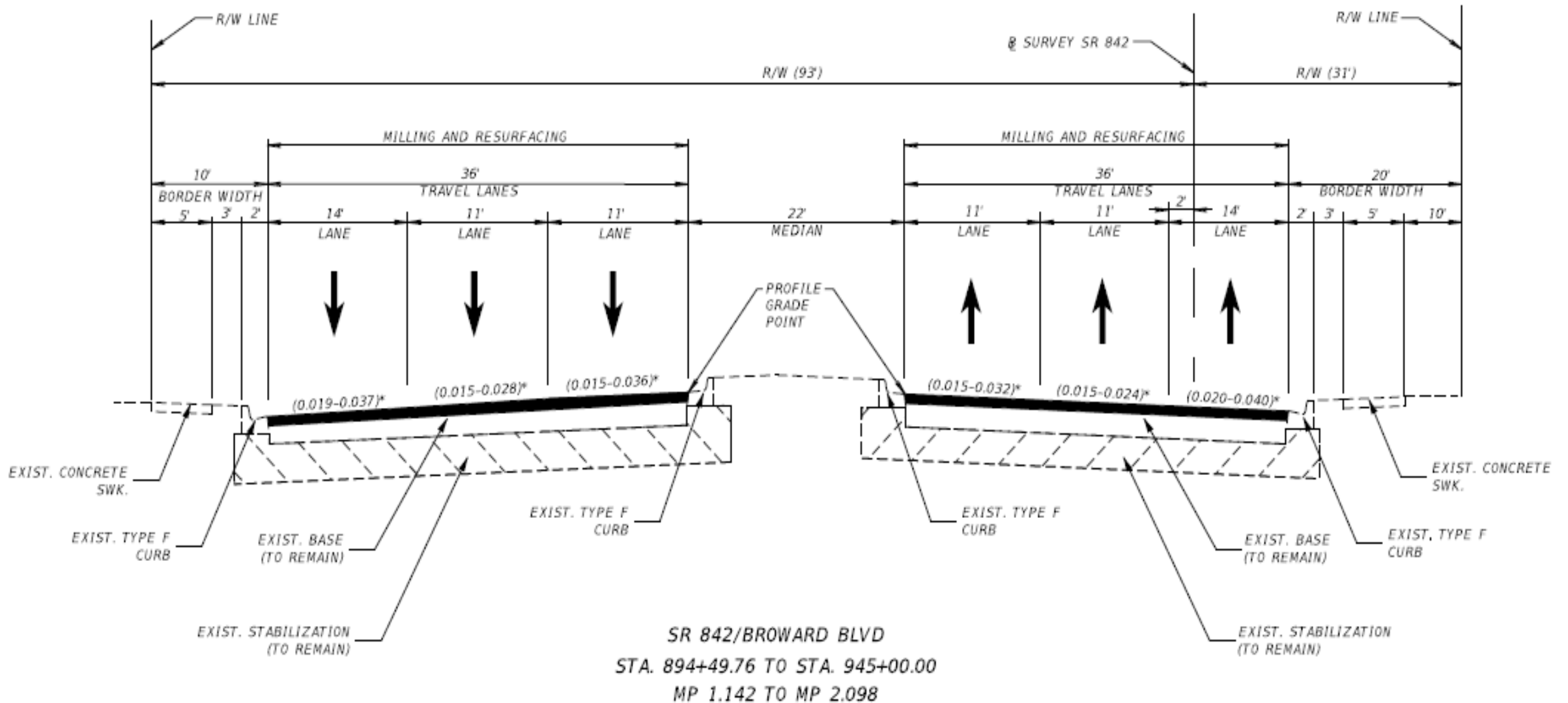

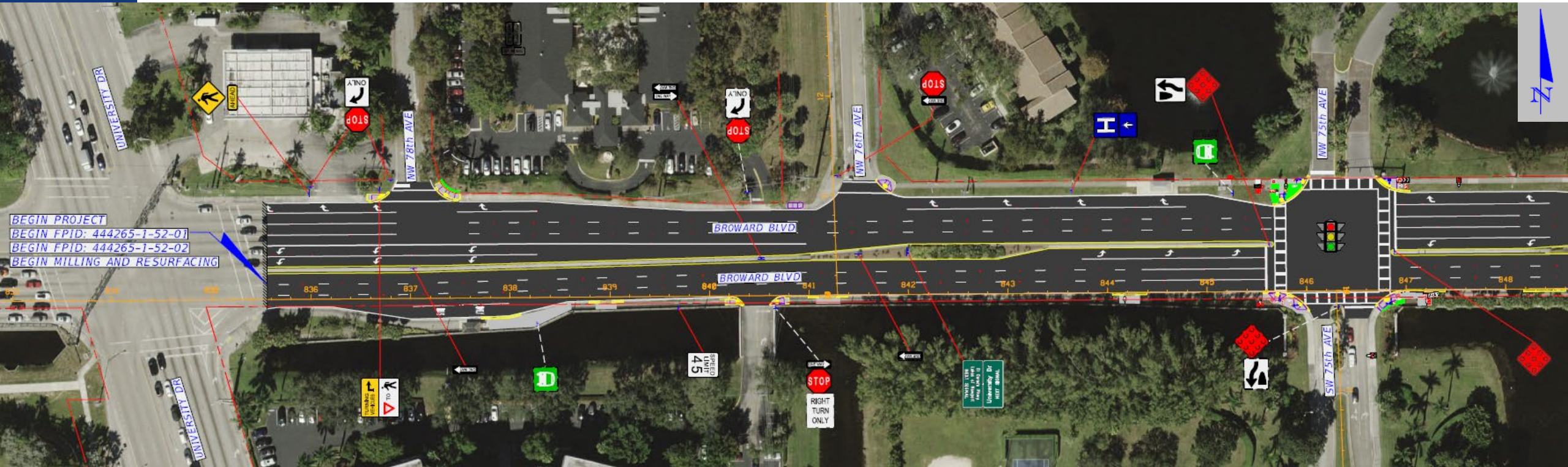

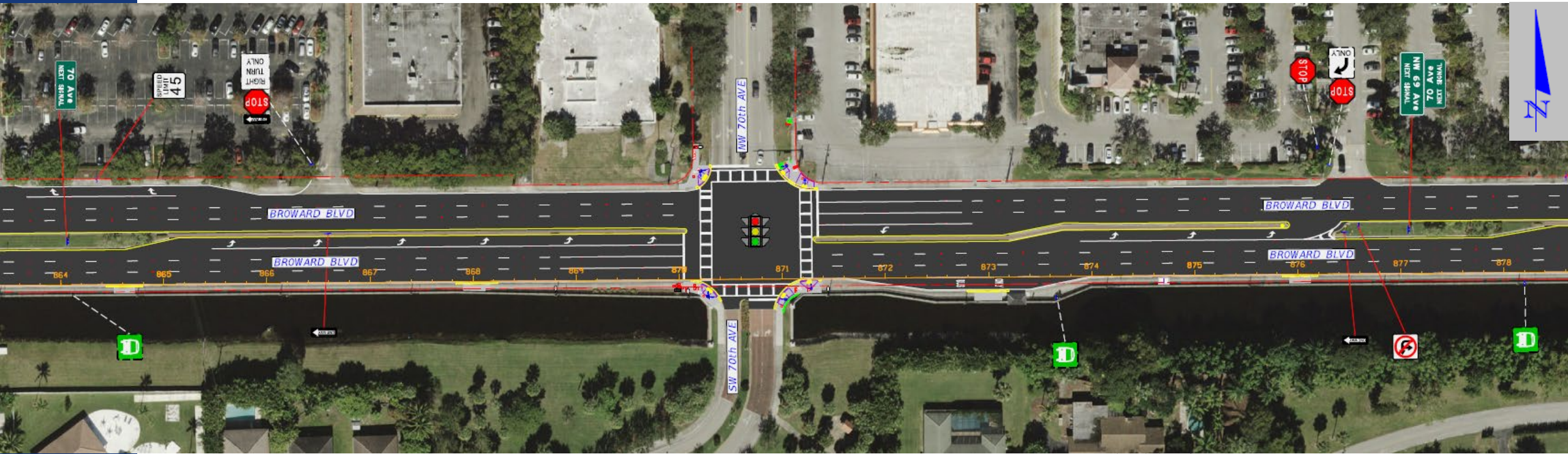

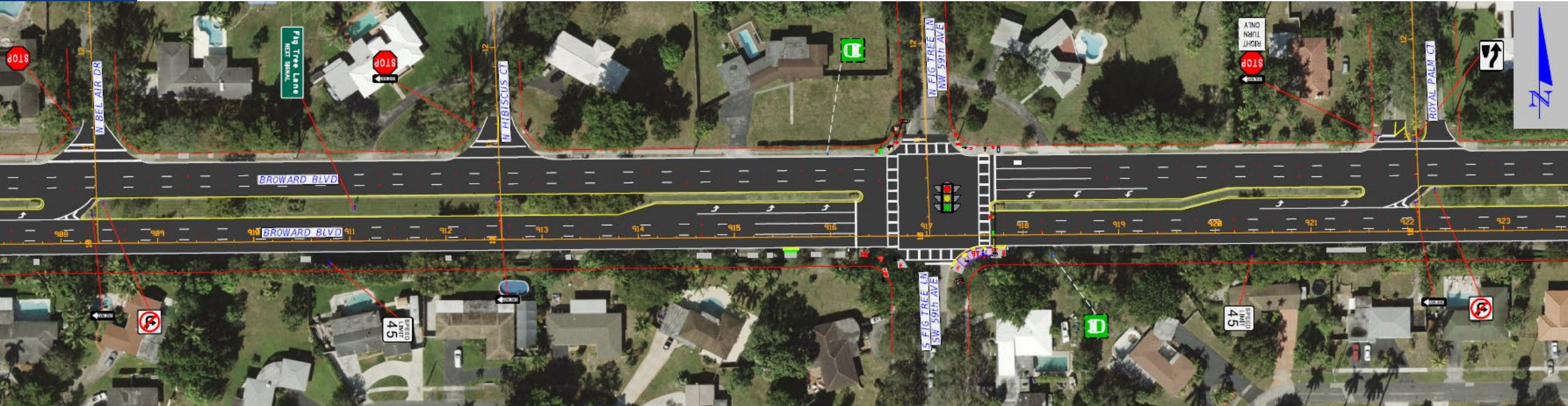

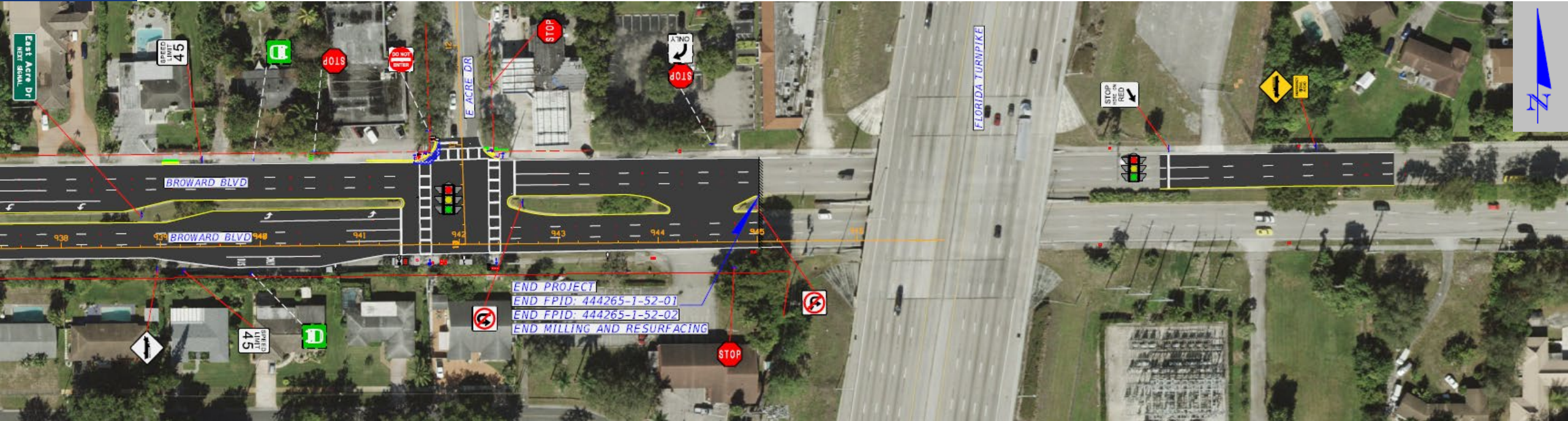

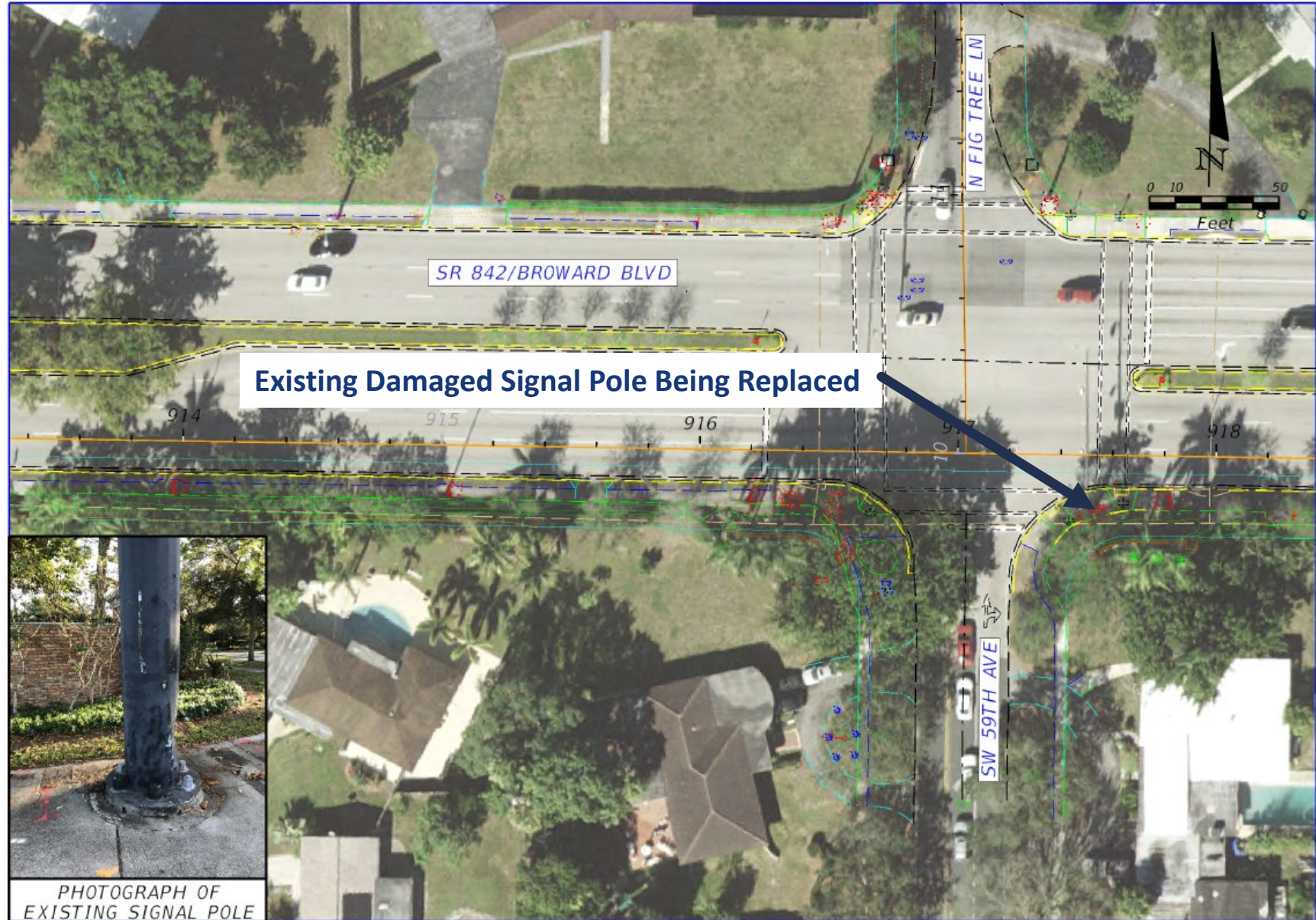

5. Temporary Traffic Control Plan

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Lane closures along Broward Boulevard shall occur only during non-peak hours on non-event days/nights/weekends
non-peak hours are:
Eastbound: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm weekdays and weekends
Westbound: 8:00 am to 4:00 pm weekdays and weekends
Eastbound & Westbound: 11:00 pm to 7:00 am Friday and Saturday nights
Eastbound & Westbound: 9:00 pm to 5:30 am Sunday through Thursday nights
- All work shall be performed during daytime only from 8am to 8pm except for paving and final striping which are to be performed at nighttime.

Construction Impacts

- All work to be done in phases to reduce the impacts of construction to the community
- Daytime temporary lane closures during non-peak hours will occur
- No full roadway closures will occur
- Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times during construction



6. Project Schedule and Cost

Project Schedule and Cost

- **Currently in Design – Biddability (90%)**
- **Design Completion – November 2021**
- **Construction Start Date – Fall 2022**
- **Estimated Construction Cost - \$3.5 million**

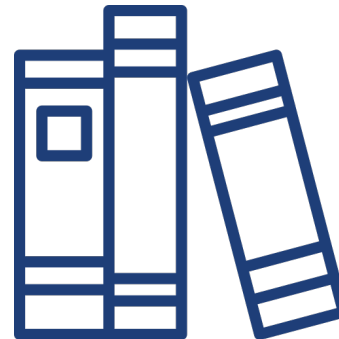

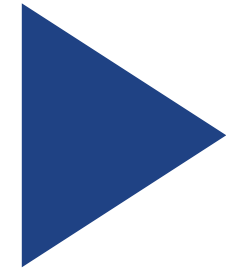

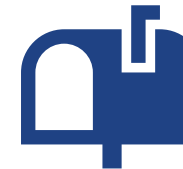
