NW 136TH AVENUE AT SR 84 INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, has awarded a contract to Lead Engineering Contractors, LLC., for improvements along NW 136th Avenue at SR 84, near the I-595 interchange. The project is located within the cities of Davie, Plantation, and Sunrise.

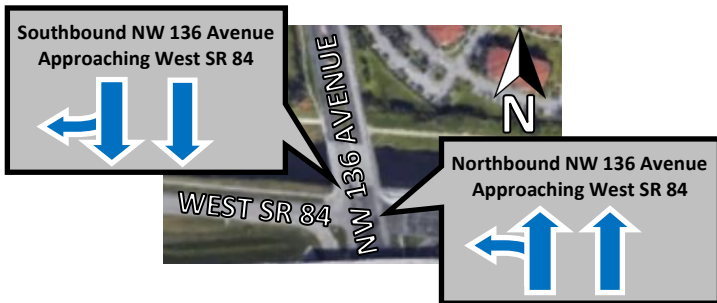
Construction Cost: \$6.4 million Construction Start Date: May 6, 2019 Anticipated Completion: Early 2021

MAJOR PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing and widening the existing bridge over the North New River Canal, resulting in an additional southbound through lane and designated bike lanes.
- Adding a designated right-turn lane from westbound SR 84 to northbound NW 136th Avenue.
- Upgrading existing lighting to LED.

TRAFFIC IMPACT

- During the replacement of the bridge, traffic will be reduced to 2 lanes in each direction as shown in the configuration below:



- Single lane closures may occur overnight, Sunday through Thursday, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Additional lane closure and detour information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
