The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation project between the Miami-Dade/Broward County Line and SR 824/Pembroke Road in the cities of Hallandale Beach and Hollywood. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$3,966,167 **Construction Start:** November 2024 **Estimated Completion:** Summer 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience
- Constructing a directional traffic median opening at the intersection of SE 5th Street/Breeze Way to enhance vehicular safety
- Upgrading existing pedestrian signals at signalized intersections to improve push button accessibility
- Upgrading concrete sidewalks, curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and connectivity

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures along SR 5/US 1 are permitted 9:30 p.m. until 7:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
