PINE RIDGE DRIVE AT UNIVERSITY DRIVE CONTINUOUS CLOSURE OCT. 28 — NOV. 15

Pine Ridge Drive entrance and exit at University Drive will be closed, around the clock, for pipeline crossing operation, beginning 7 a.m., Monday, Oct. 28 through 4 p.m., Friday, Nov. 15. Access to local traffic will be maintained at all times and proper detour signage will be in place to assist motorists and pedestrians.

Traffic from University Drive will be detoured via eastbound Wiles Road and northbound Riverside Drive or eastbound Westview Drive and southbound Riverside Drive to access Pine Ridge Drive. Pedestrian detours will be implemented to ensure access is maintained around the work zone.

Residents who wish to access University Drive from Pine Ridge Drive will need to use Riverside Drive and proceed to either Westview Drive or Wiles Road.



The project improvements consist of widening the roadway to accommodate one additional travel lane and bicycle lane, relocating the existing 6-foot sidewalk from NW 40th Street to SR 869/Sawgrass Expressway, relocating impacted drainage structures and regrading swales to ensure proper drainage flow, upgrading traffic and pedestrian signals at NW 40th Street and Westview Drive, installation of 77 light poles along the project corridor, milling and resurfacing within the project limits, and upgrading curb ramps, signing, and pavement markings.
