### SR 810/HILLSBORO BOULEVARD RESURFACING, RESTORATION, AND REHABILITATION (RRR) PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the SR 810/Hillsboro Boulevard Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project. The project limits are on SR 810/Hillsboro Boulevard from SR 7/US 441 to SR 845/Powerline Road in the cities of Coconut Creek and Deerfield Beach. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities. Please see below for detailed project information.

**Construction Cost:** \$7,765,433

**Construction Start:** November 2024

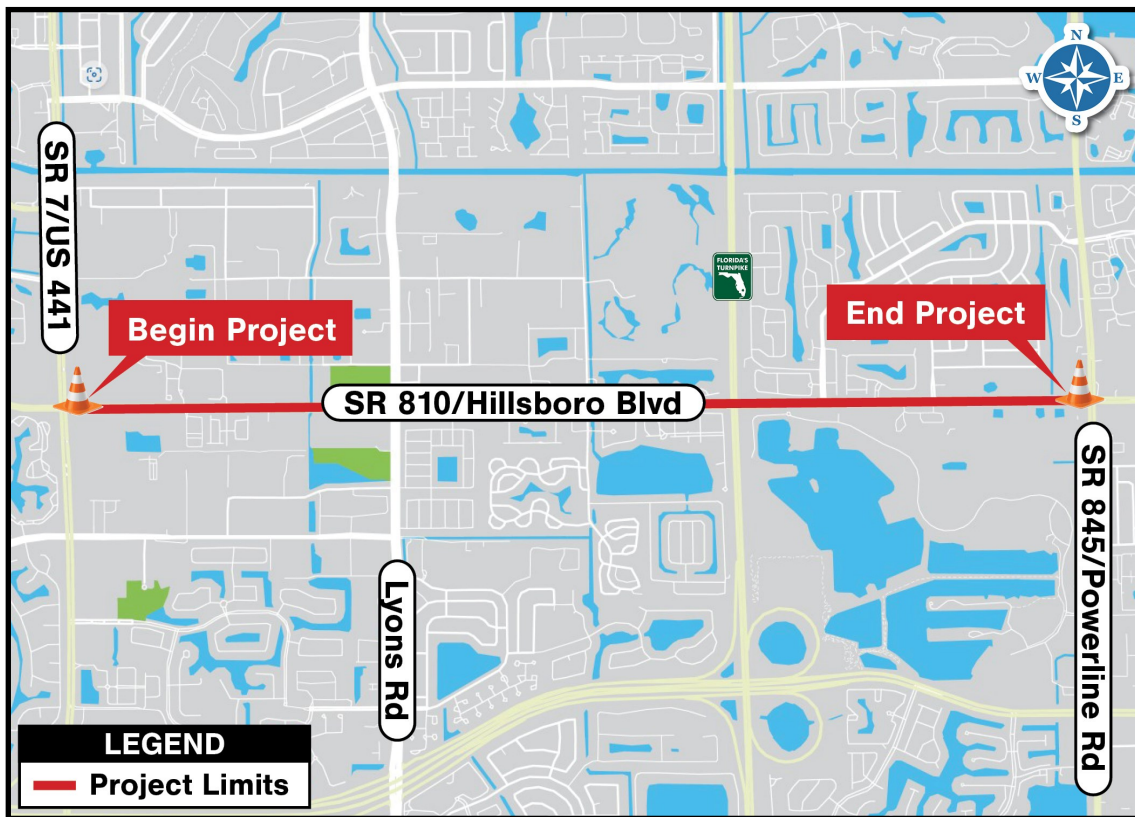
**Estimated Completion:** Late 2025

#### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway along the project limits to enhance infrastructure resilience and safety for the community
- Modifying existing pavement markings along SR 810/Hillsboro Boulevard to accommodate a 7-foot dedicated bicycle lane in each direction
- Installing new mast arms at the intersection of SR 810/Hillsboro Boulevard and Lyons Road
- Upgrading existing lighting to LED fixtures along the project limits to enhance visibility and nighttime safety
- Upgrading curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage within the project limits to improve visibility and connectivity

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures are permitted daily Monday through Friday, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and nightly Sunday through Thursday, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Business and residential access will be maintained at all times throughout construction
