#### MIRAMAR PARK AND RIDE LOT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four, has awarded a contract to Zahlene Enterprises, Inc., for construction of a park and ride lot in the city of Miramar.

#### **PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS**

- Constructing a new park and ride lot with 488 parking spaces, including handicap and bus spaces, bus shelters, sidewalks and bicycle racks.
- Installing landscaping and lighting within the parking lot.
- Adding school zone signage and a right turn lane on Pembroke Road.

#### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Daytime single lane closures will occur along Hiatus Road, Miramar Boulevard, and Pembroke Road.
- Additional lane closure information will be provided in the weekly traffic report distributed by FDOT.
