SR 93/I-75 ALLIGATOR ALLEY RESURFACING, RESTORATION, AND REHABILITATION (RRR) PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide the community with information about the SR 93/I-75 Alligator Alley Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project with limits from Mile Post (MP) 31.261 to the Everglades Toll Plaza (MP 18.873) in Broward County. This project aims to enhance the safety, resilience, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$24,576,002

Construction Start: November 2024

Estimated Completion: Fall 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience.
- Replacing guardrail within the project limits to enhance safety.
- Upgrading signing and pavement markings within the project limits to enhance nighttime visibility and safety.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Single lane closures along SR 93/I-75 are permitted as needed from 9:00 p.m. until 11:00 a.m.
- Extended single lane closures at bridge locations are permitted as needed for guardrail replacement.
- Access to rest areas and boat ramps will be maintained at all times.
