SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation (RRR) Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is pleased to provide information regarding the upcoming SR 5/US 1 Resurfacing, Restoration, and Rehabilitation project between the Miami-Dade/Broward County Line and SR 824/Pembroke Road in the cities of Hallandale Beach and Hollywood. This project aims to enhance the safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure for our communities.

Construction Cost: \$3,966,167

Construction Start: November 2024

Estimated Completion: Summer 2025

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term resilience
- Constructing a directional traffic median opening at the intersection of SE 5th Street/Breeze Way to enhance vehicular safety
- Upgrading existing pedestrian signals at signalized intersections to improve push button accessibility
- Upgrading concrete sidewalks, curb ramps, pavement markings, and signage to improve visibility and connectivity

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lane closures along SR 5/US 1 are permitted 9:30 p.m. until 7:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
