PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway
- Modifying pavement markings along SR 5/US 1/Federal Highway to accommodate 4-foot bicycle lanes in each direction
- Upgrading pedestrian signals with countdown timers and LED lighting at various intersections
- Upgrading signage, pavement markings, sidewalks, and curb ramps



- Lane closures along SR 5/US 1/Federal Highway are permitted Sunday through Thursday, between 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m., and Monday through Friday between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- Work is limited to one intersection at a time between 10:00 p.m., Friday until 6:00 a.m., Monday (continuous operation).
- Motorist and pedestrian access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times.
