I-95 SOUTHBOUND AT SAMPLE ROAD TO CLOSE SUNDAY NIGHT, NOV. 13

The SR-9/I-95 southbound lanes, between SR-834/Sample Road and Copans Road, will be closed to traffic overnight, 10 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. on Sunday, Nov. 13, for removal of an overhead sign structure. The first lane will close at 10 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., three lanes will close at 12:30 a.m. and all lanes will be closed by 1 a.m. Motorists traveling on SR-9/I-95 southbound will be detoured via the SR-834/Sample Road exit ramp, N. Andrews Avenue, and Copans Road. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists. In association with this closure, the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR-834/Sample Road will also be closed. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR-834/Sample Road wishing to access SR-9/I-95 southbound will be detoured via SR-834/Sample Road, SR-811/Dixie Highway, and Copans Road. Motorists traveling westbound on SR-834/Sample Road wishing to access SR-9/I-95 southbound will be detoured via SR-834/Sample Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. Monday, Nov. 14 and Tuesday, Nov. 15 will be used as contingency nights if needed.



This project will consist of constructing a dedicated merge lane for SR-9/I-95 northbound traffic from Copans Road that is physically separated from the I-95 general purpose lanes, constructing a parallel road for I-95 southbound traffic entering and exiting onto Copans Road, and constructing noise walls. Improvements will also include installing drainage and landscaping, updating the lighting and intelligent transportation systems (ITS), roadway widening, milling, resurfacing, signage and pavement markings, sidewalk, and curb and gutter.
