



Scope of Work

Roadway Features

- Removing existing brick pavers at the following intersections:
 - NW/SW 7th Avenue, N/S Andrews Avenue, NE/SE 3rd Avenue, SR 5/US-1/N Federal Highway
 - Milling and resurfacing with asphalt
 - Upgrading signing and pavement markings

Concrete restoration at the following locations:


- S Andrews Avenue (SE Corner), SE 3rd Avenue (SW Corner)
 - Signalization
 - Concrete curb ramp reconstruction

Scope of Work


Lighting Features

- Lighting Upgrades at the following Intersections:
 - NW/SW 7th Avenue/Avenue of the Arts, NW/SW 5th Avenue,
 NW/SW 1st Avenue, N/S Andrews Avenue, NE/SE 3rd Avenue
 - Replacing existing lighting with LED lights, lighting components including conductors, conduit, wiring, and installing new light poles

Maintenance of Traffic

Public Safety is our Top Priority!

- Work Zone Signage
 - Advanced warning and project signage will be placed throughout the construction corridor
 - Lighted message boards will be located at the eastern and western project limits



- Ongoing coordination with local agencies and businesses to ensure bus route accessibility and access at all times
 - Broward County Traffic Engineering Division
 - City of Fort Lauderdale

Maintenance of Traffic

Lane Closure Details Weekdays

- One lane will be closed in each direction Monday through Thursday for the following activities:
 - Lighting, signal improvements, and sidewalk restoration
 - 9:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., nightly
- Lane closures are not permitted during peak hours:
 - Weekdays
 – 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m.

Weekends

- Multiple lanes will be closed along Broward Boulevard including detour of side streets, Friday through Sunday for the following activities:
 - Brick paver removal, concrete header removal, and asphalt operations
 - 9:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., nightly
- One lane will be maintained in each direction along Broward Boulevard except for Federal Highway Improvements

Effort to Minimize Impacts


- The Department desires to expedite construction on this project to minimize impacts to the traveling public and to reduce the time of construction.






