The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information about the proposed resurfacing and safety improvements project along SR 91/I-75 Alligator Alley from west of US 27 to the Collier County line in Broward County, Florida. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- ▶ Safety upgrades will be added along SR 91/I-75 Alligator Way through the addition of medians and new guardrail installation.
- ▶ Milling and resurfacing along the corridor will increase the service life of the pavement.

PROJECT BENEFITS

- ▶ Additional safety features are provided to protect vehicles from roadside hazards.
- ▶ The service life of the roadway pavement will be extended for an additional 20 years.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- ▶ Work will be done along I-75 Alligator Alley mainline and shoulders from just west of US 27 to the Collier County Line.
- ▶ Construction activities will be limited to 2-mile increments to minimize traffic impacts.

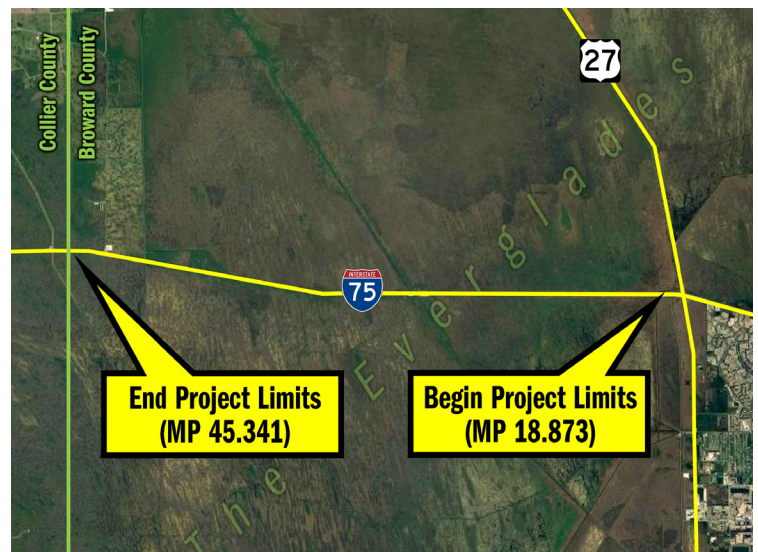
