The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Virtual Public Meeting regarding the proposed City of Oakland Park Sidewalk Improvement Project. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Construct sidewalks at various locations within the neighborhoods of Central Oakland Park and Harlem McBride.
- Relocate signs to meet the minimum horizontal sidewalk clearances to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.
- Relocate impacted drainage structures.
- Regrade swales for proper drainage conveyance.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- All work will be done in phases to reduce the impact of construction to the community.
- No full roadway closures will occur.
- Single lane closures will occur between the hours of 9:00 am – 3:30 pm (weekdays and weekends).
- Access to private properties will be maintained during construction.

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Construction Start Date: Spring 2022
- Anticipated Completion: Summer 2023
- Construction Cost Estimate: \$2 Million
