SR 704/Okeechobee Boulevard RRR Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to a Virtual Public Meeting and In-Person Construction Open House regarding the upcoming SR 704/Okeechobee Boulevard RRR Project. This project aims to enhance safety, resiliency, and longevity of the infrastructure in our communities. Please see below for detailed meeting information.

Construction Cost: \$3.2 Million **Construction Start:** January 2025 **Anticipated Completion:** Early 2026

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling, repaving, and restriping the existing roadway within the project limits to ensure long-term infrastructure resilience and safety
- Upgrading pedestrian signals and lighting to LED fixtures at existing crosswalks to enhance pedestrian safety and connectivity
- Replacing in-road sensors and traffic signal backplates to improve traffic flow and enhance safety for motorists
- Installing Wrong Way Driving Systems (WWDS) at the SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps to SR 704/Okeechobee Boulevard to enhance safety by detecting wrong-way drivers and alerting the driver, other motorists and first responders of the impending danger

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Work will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- Single lane closures are permitted nightly as needed from 8:30 p.m. until 6:30 a.m.
- Full closures of the SR 9/I-95 exit ramps are permitted nightly as needed, 8:30 p.m. until 6:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for WWDS Installation
- Sidewalk and curb ramp closures will be implemented as needed, restricting access to one direction of travel at a time
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times

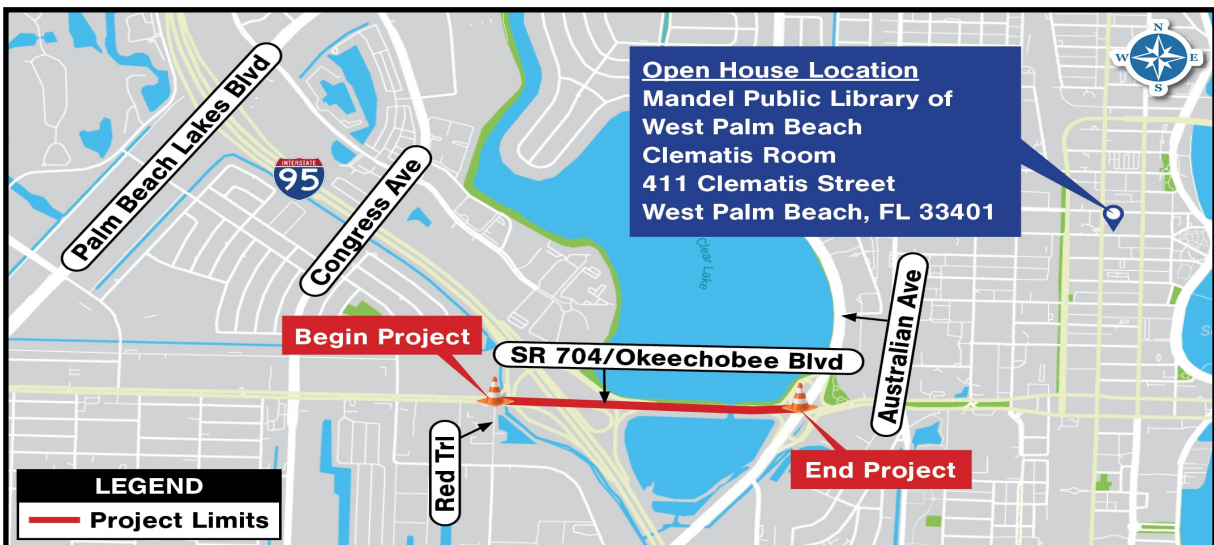
