The purpose of this lighting project is to improve the lighting conditions and meet current FDOT lighting retrofit criteria.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replace existing luminaires on Florida Power and Light (FP&L) owned poles to ensure corridor lighting uniformity and it meets FDOT lighting criteria.
- The construction of this project will be completed by FP&L.

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- The MOT plan will be designed by FP&L.
- At least one access point to each adjacent property will be maintained throughout construction.

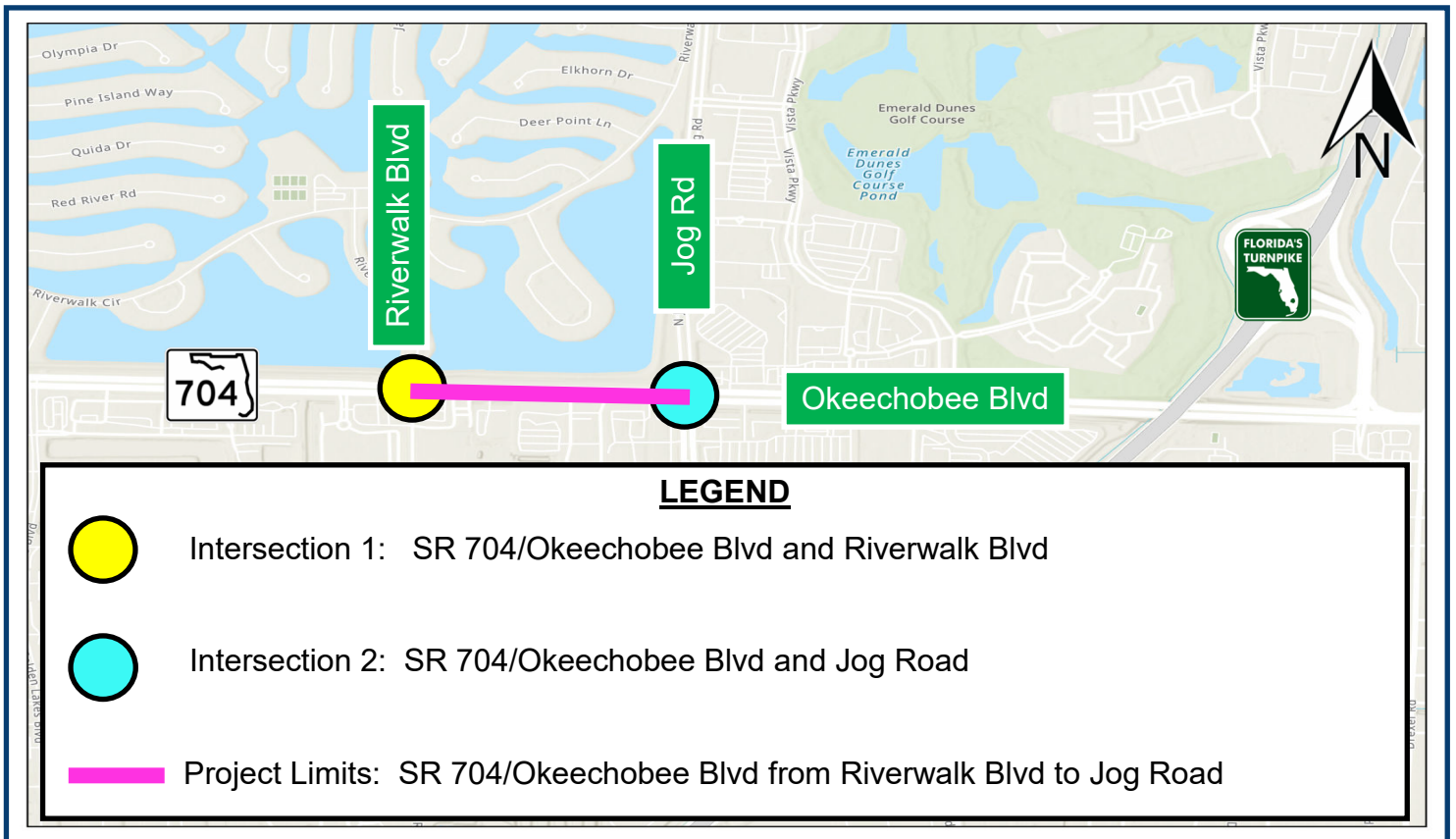
