

FULL CLOSURE OF BELLEAIR AVENUE AT S.R. 607/EMERSON AVENUE FOR DRAINAGE WORK DEC. 1-3

To ensure community and public safety as we work to enhance the roadway and provide a safer and more resilient infrastructure, Belleair Avenue at S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue will be closed around-the-clock from 9 a.m., Monday, Dec. 1, through approximately 5 p.m., Wednesday, Dec. 3, for drainage work. If weather or unforeseen circumstances arise, Belleair Avenue will reopen by Friday, Dec. 12. Signage will be posted to direct motorists.

- Eastbound Belleair Avenue motorists will be detoured via north on S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue to southeast on Fort Pierce Boulevard, to south onto Belleair Avenue.
- Westbound Belleair Avenue motorists to southbound S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue will be detoured via southbound Lee Boulevard to westbound Brookline Avenue to S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue.
- Westbound Belleair Avenue to northbound S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue motorists will be detoured via northwest onto Fort Pierce Boulevard to S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue.
- Southbound S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue to Belleair Avenue will be detoured via eastbound on Fort Pierce Boulevard to southbound on Belleair Avenue.
- Northbound S.R. 607/Emerson Avenue to Belleair Avenue will be detoured via eastbound on Brookline Avenue, to northbound Lee Boulevard, to westbound Belleair Avenue.
- Access to local residences on Belleair Avenue will be maintained.
