

State Road (SR) 710/Beeline Highway Reconstruction Project In the cities of Palm Beach Gardens, Riviera Beach, West Palm Beach and the Town of Loxahatchee Groves Palm Beach County, FL Financial Project ID Number: 419251-1-52-01, 02, 03

SR 710/Beeline Highway from Haverhill Road to North Jog Road to CLOSE NIGHTLY, March 23– April 4, 2025

- Starting Sunday night, Mar. 23, from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., SR 710/Beeline Highway between just north of the Haverhill Road intersection and just south of the North Jog Road intersection will be closed nightly, Sunday through Thursday, to allow for the safe demolition of the SR 91/Florida's Turnpike bridge
- Motorists traveling southeast on SR 710/Beeline Highway will be detoured north on North Jog Road, east on Northlake Boulevard, south on SR 809/North Military Trail, west on SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard and northwest to SR 710/Beeline Highway
- Motorists traveling northwest on SR 710/Beeline Highway will be detoured southeast on SR 710/Beeline Highway, east on SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard, north on SR 809/North Military Trail, west on Northlake Boulevard, south on Jog Road and northwest on SR 710/Beeline Highway
- Flaggers will be on-site, and signage will be posted along the detour route to assist motorists



Construction Cost: \$148.2 million Construction Start: March 2024 **Estimated Completion:** Late 2029

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Widening of SR 710/Beeline Highway from Northlake Boulevard to SR 708/Blue Heron Boulevard from 4 lanes to 6 lanes
- Replacing and widening the Florida's Turnpike bridge over SR 710/Beeline Highway
- Constructing an at-grade partial Continuous Flow Intersection (CFI) at the intersection of SR 710/Beeline Highway and Northlake Boulevard
- Adding sidewalks and bicycle lanes on both sides of SR 710/Beeline Highway
- Constructing an 8-foot high privacy wall adjacent to the Steeplechase Community along SR 710/Beeline Highway
- Upgrading railroad crossings, drainage, signage, lighting, signalization, and pavement markings throughout project limits
- Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) upgrades
