CLOSURE OF SOUTHBOUND S.R. 9/I-95 OFF-RAMP TO EASTBOUND S.R. 706/INDIANTOWN ROAD FOR MARCH 3, 2026

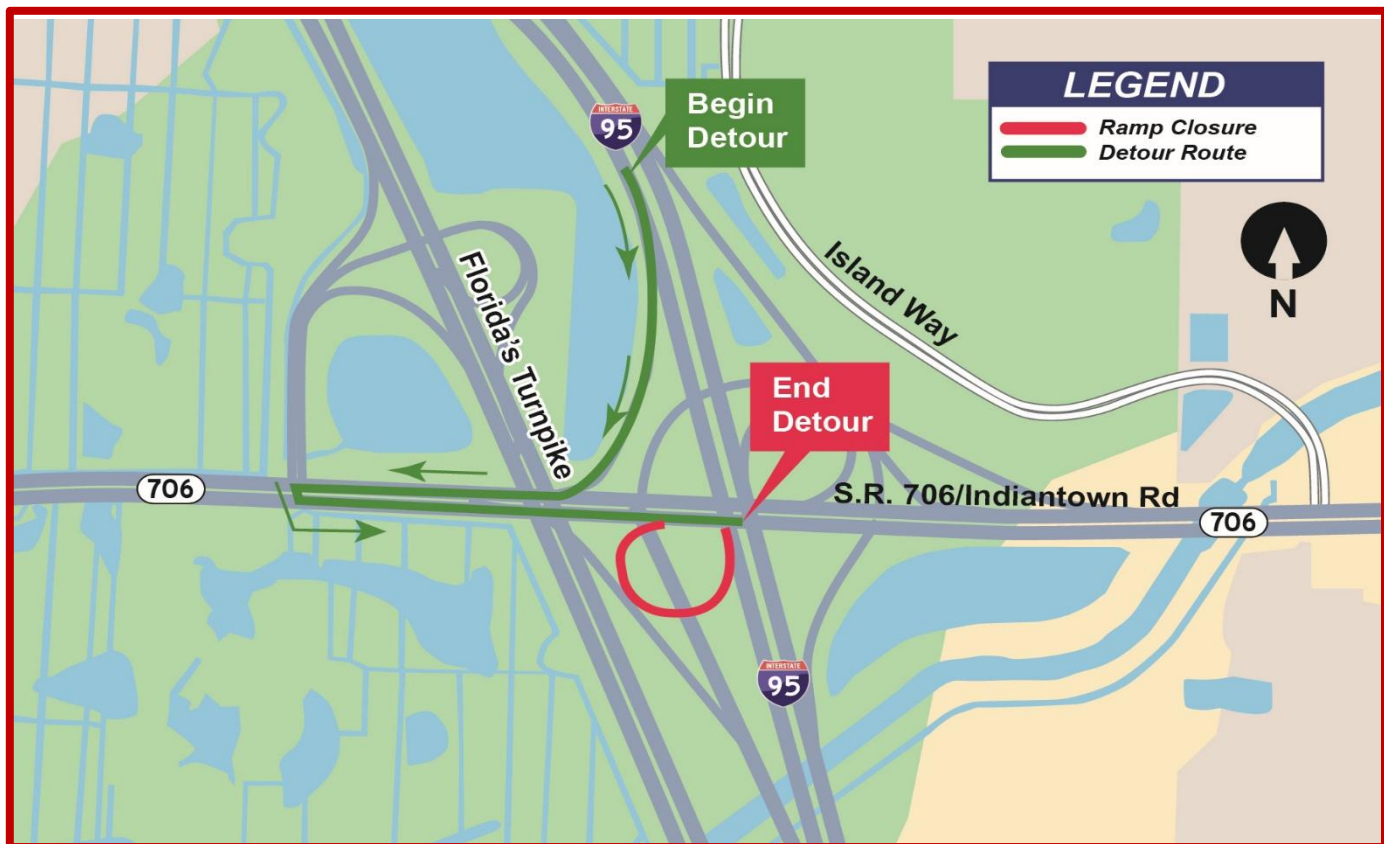
OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 off-ramp to eastbound S.R. 706/Indiantown Road in the Town of Jupiter for high friction surface installation. The closure will begin at 8 p.m. on Tuesday, March 3, 2026, until 6 a.m. the following day. Crews may require Wednesday, March 4 and Thursday, March 5, 2026, as contingency dates to finalize the work. Please be advised, this schedule may change due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.

Detour Information:

- Take the westbound exit for S.R. 706/Indiantown Road and make a U-turn at the Florida's Turnpike entrance onto eastbound S.R. 706/Indiantown Road.

Please note, detours will not overlap with ongoing closures.
