
- Milling and Resurfacing of Rural and Urban Mainline



Existing Typical Section 1: Rural Mainline








Proposed Typical Section 2: Urban Mainline

- Upgraded sidewalk connectivity
- ADA upgrades
- Upgraded curb ramps
- Reconstructed driveways

- Upgraded traffic signals
- Enhanced bicycle lanes
- Updated signing and pavement markings

Maintenance of Traffic

- During construction, single lane closures will be used to construct, roadway widening, drainage improvements, sidewalk, and signal replacement activities
- No vehicular detours or full road/intersection closures
- Temporary impacts to pedestrian traffic will be addressed via temporary pedestrian detours/diversions as required


