### STATE ROAD 9 / I-95 NORTHBOUND OFF-RAMP AT BELVEDERE ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Virtual Public Meeting regarding the improvements for SR 9 / I-95 Northbound Off-Ramp at Belvedere Road in Palm Beach County and the City of West Palm Beach. This meeting will start at 5:30 p.m. followed by a question and answer session. #### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Add a second right-turn lane on the northbound off-ramp at Belvedere Road and provide shoulders
- Widen, mill and resurface the existing northbound off-ramp and eastbound Belvedere Road
- Upgrade signals at intersection with new mast arms and pedestrian countdown signals
- Add signal control for right turn movements
- Implement Wrong Way Driving Countermeasure System
- Upgrade signing and pavement markings, and lighting at the intersection
- Minor modifications to drainage, sidewalk, and curb and gutter
- Relocate existing trees impacted by proposed improvements

#### CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be completed in phases to minimize construction impacts
- Single lane closures will be required during construction along eastbound Belvedere Road and the I-95 northbound off-ramp to Belvedere Road
- Off-ramp access will be maintained throughout construction

#### CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Project Letting: **July 27, 2022**
- Construction Begins: **Fall 2022**
- Anticipated Completion: **Winter 2023**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$2.2 million**
