Project Overview

Proposed Improvements:

- Repave the existing roadway
- Upgrade pedestrian signals and midblock crossings
- Install new sidewalk east side between White Drive and Bucida Road
- Upgrade lighting at signalized intersections
- Improve safety

Project Length: 1.6 miles

Project Overview

Objective:

- Preserve and extend the service life of the pavement
- Enhance highway safety by adding sidewalk where missing, retrofitting lighting at signalized intersections and mid-block crossings, upgrading signalization, upgrading mid-block flashing beacons to Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB)








Example of pedestrian midblock crossing upgrade with RRFB




Example of signalized intersection lighting upgrade

What to Expect During Construction



Closures/Detours:

- Limited lane closures (*one direction at a time*) will occur during paving operations
 - Daytime in residential area
 - Flagger Operation
- Pedestrian detours will occur; however, one side of the sidewalk will remain open at all times
- Shoulder closures will occur for the signalization and mid-block crossing work (*one direction at a time*)
 - During this time, bicycle traffic will be maintained on the road using shared lane markings
- Closures and detours will be clearly delineated



Temporary Traffic Control Plan

What to Expect During Construction



Speed:

Existing 30 and 35 Mile Per Hour (MPH) limit will remain

Project Phasing:

Work will be done in phases to reduce the impacts of construction in the community

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

What to Expect During Construction



Dust:

The contractor will be required to water and sweep in order to minimize construction-related dust



Noise:


Some noise should be expected during daytime hours



Access:

Access to businesses and residential properties will be maintained at all times during construction

Estimated Construction Cost: \$1.2 million






