The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding the improvements along SR 805/Dixie Highway from eastbound SR 802/Lake Avenue to westbound SR 802/Lucerne Avenue. No public meeting is scheduled for this project.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing new traffic signals at the intersections of SR 802/Lake Avenue and SR 802/Lucerne Avenue
- Installing a flashing yellow arrow for all left turns at the intersections
- Upgrading pedestrian signal features
- Reconstruction of sidewalk affected by mast arm and light pole installation
- Upgrading lighting at the intersections

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

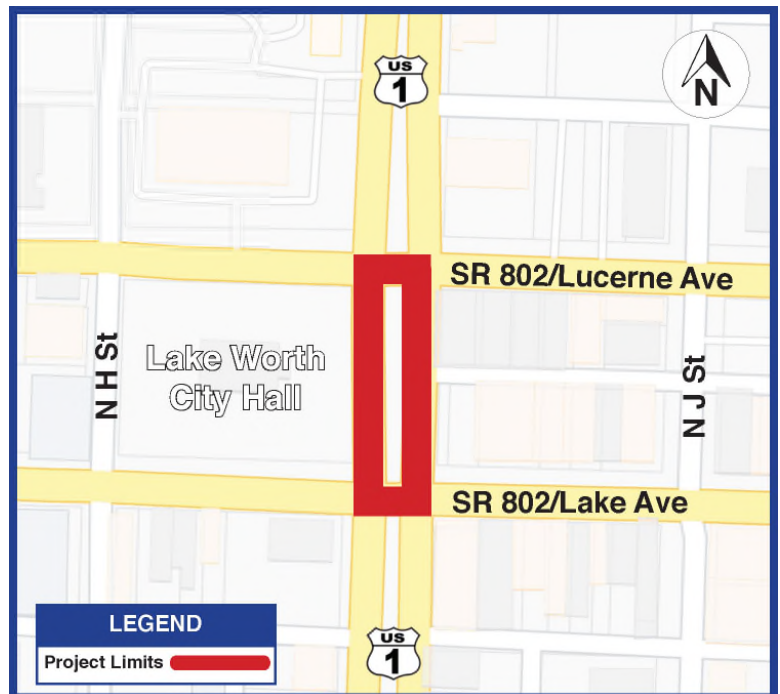
- Construction will be allowed on one corner at a time
- No full roadway closures are anticipated
- All lane closures will occur during non-peak hours
- Access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times during construction
