SR 802/Lake Worth Road from Raulerson Dr. to Palm Beach State College Entrance

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Hybrid Public Information Workshop regarding the improvements for SR 802/Lake Worth Road from Raulerson Drive to Palm Beach State College Entrance. The workshop will begin with a presentation followed by a question and answer period. Attendees can ask questions and/or make comments via the chat function or in-person for project representatives to answer.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurface and restripe roadway pavement
- 7-foot separated bicycle lanes in both directions
- Signalized mid-block crossing east of Urquhart Street
- Pedestrian signals and intersection lighting upgrades
- Widen existing sidewalks to 8-13 feet and provide curb ramp improvements
- Drainage ponding/roadway depression repairs
- Median separators at 6 unsignalized intersections

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Single lane closure during daytime hours, occasional dual lane closures at night for resurfacing work
- Driveway and street access will be maintained throughout construction

CONSTRUCTION INFORMATION

- Construction Start Date: **Spring 2022**
- Anticipated Completion: **Summer 2024**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$6.8 Million**

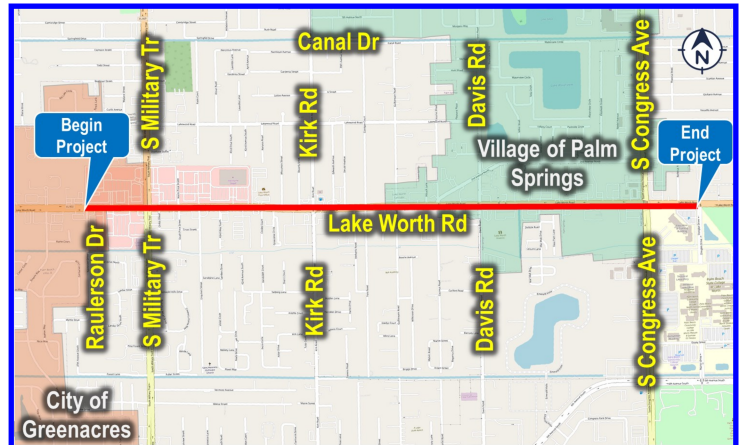
