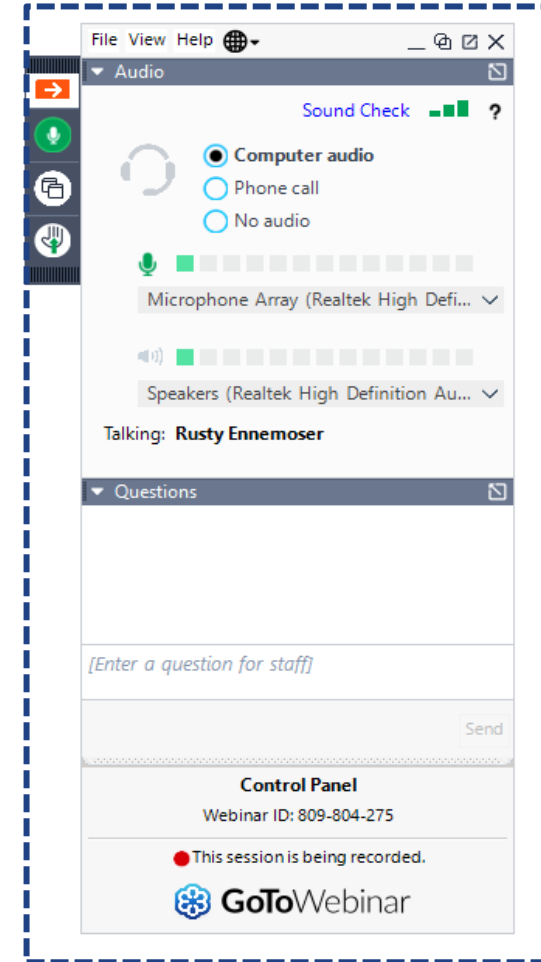

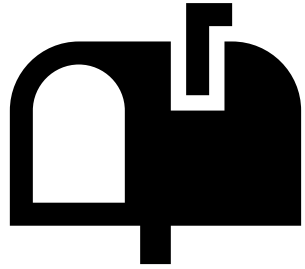

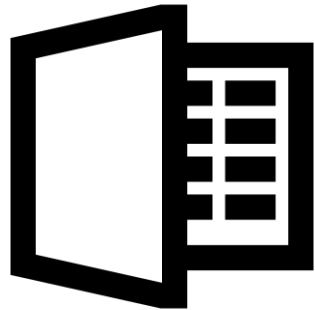

RESURFACING, RESTORATION, AND REHABILITATION (RRR) PROJECT:

SR-A1A/South Ocean Boulevard from South of Lake Avenue to North of Ibis Way



Project Length: 2.07 miles

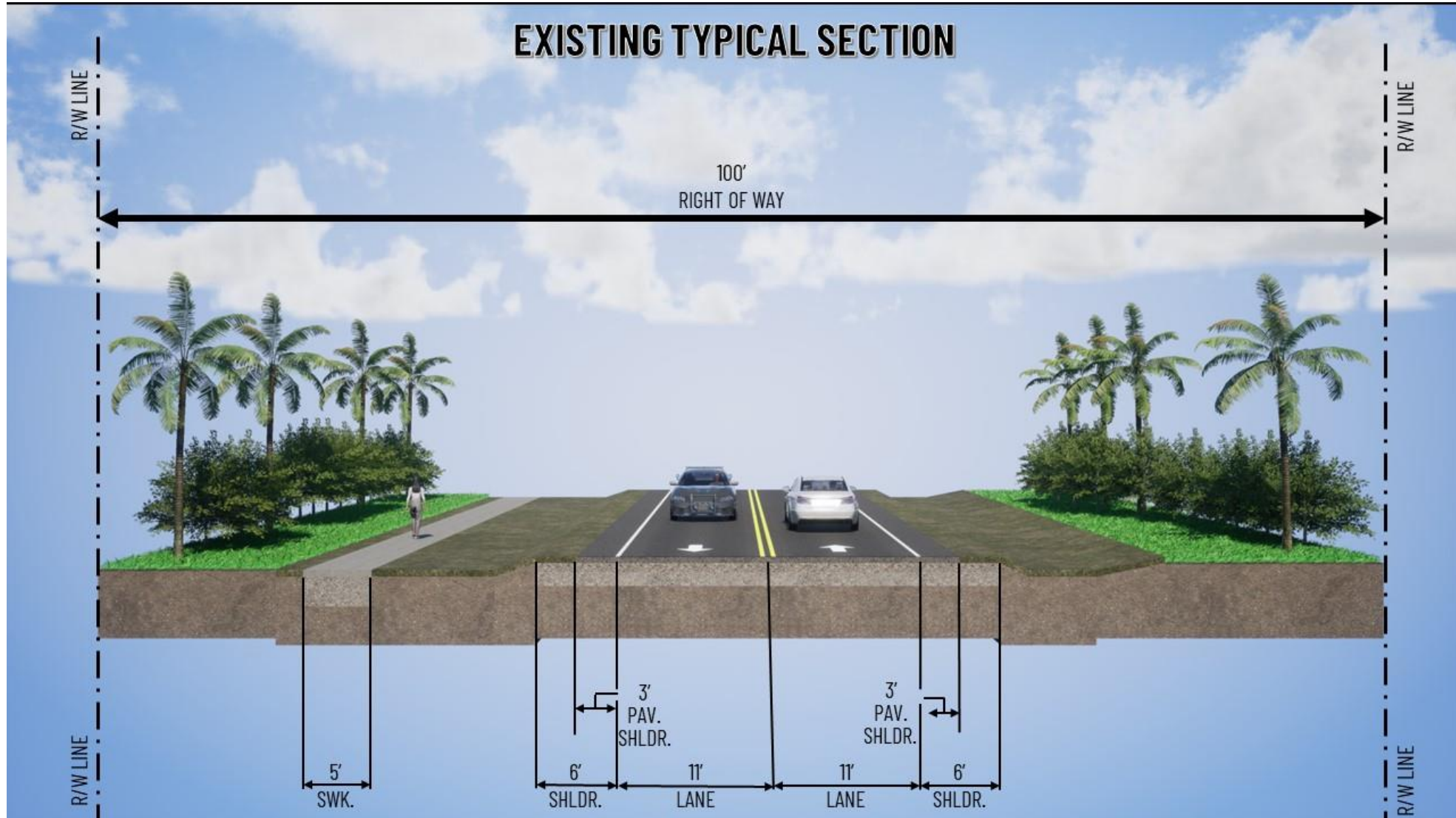
Project Overview

Proposed Improvements:

1. Repave the existing roadway
2. Widen the paved shoulder to 5-feet
3. Replace the existing 5-foot asphalt sidewalk with a 6-foot concrete sidewalk
4. Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps to meet with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
5. Upgrade signing and pavement markings
6. Upgrade lighting, and pedestrian signals at Lake Avenue, at the mid-block crossing of Raymond Floyd Golf Course, and at Phipps Ocean Park
7. Improve drainage as needed

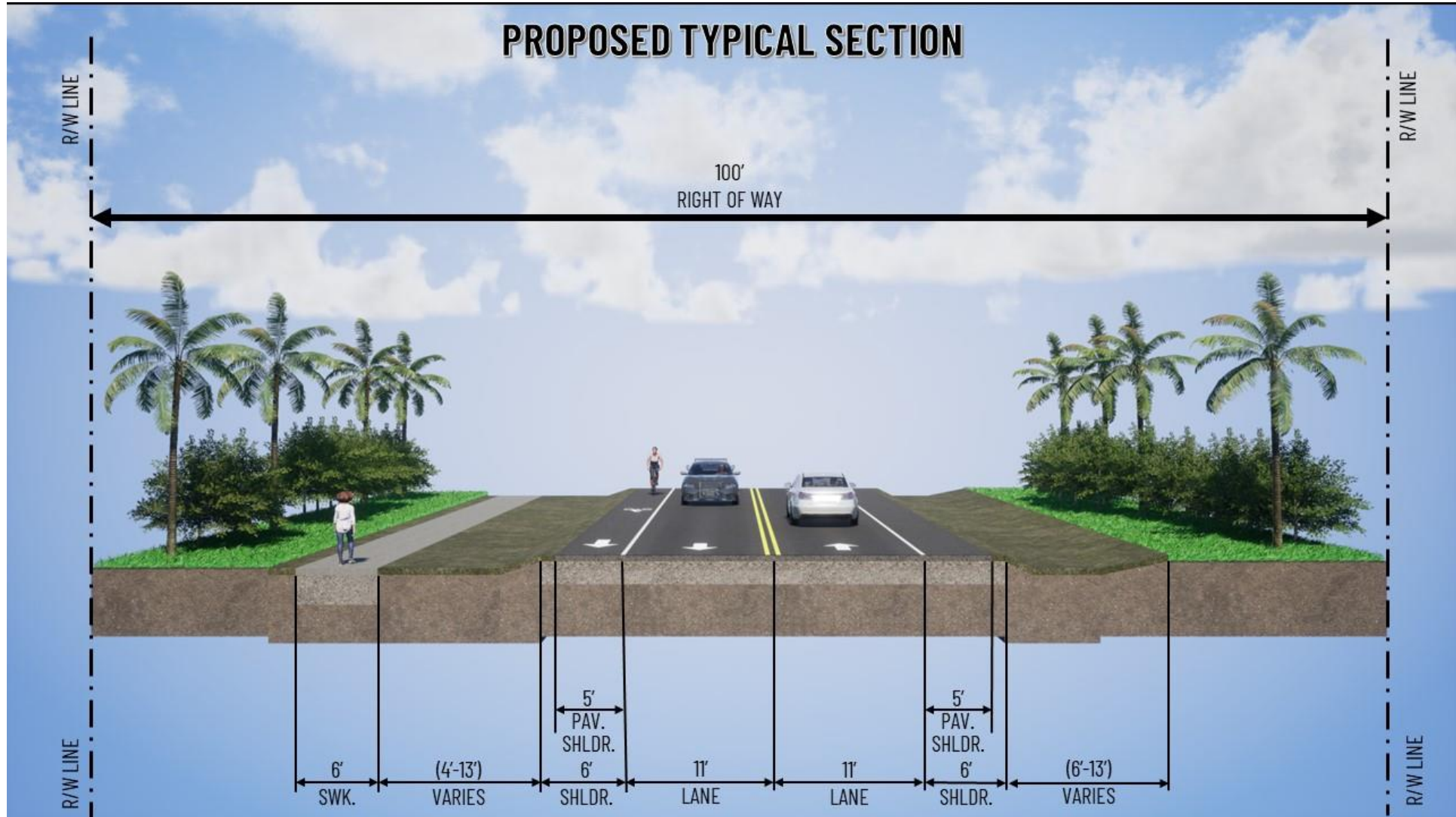

Signalization Improvements



Add retroreflective backplates to improve signal head visibility

Replacement of pedestrian push-buttons and signal heads to meet ADA

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

Temporary Traffic Control Plan

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community
- Temporary lane closures will be required during daytime and nighttime hours:
 - Nighttime lane closures will be required when working within 800-feet of Lake Avenue
 - Daytime lane closure will be implemented for the remainder of the project
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
- No detours are necessary

Estimated Completion: Late 2025

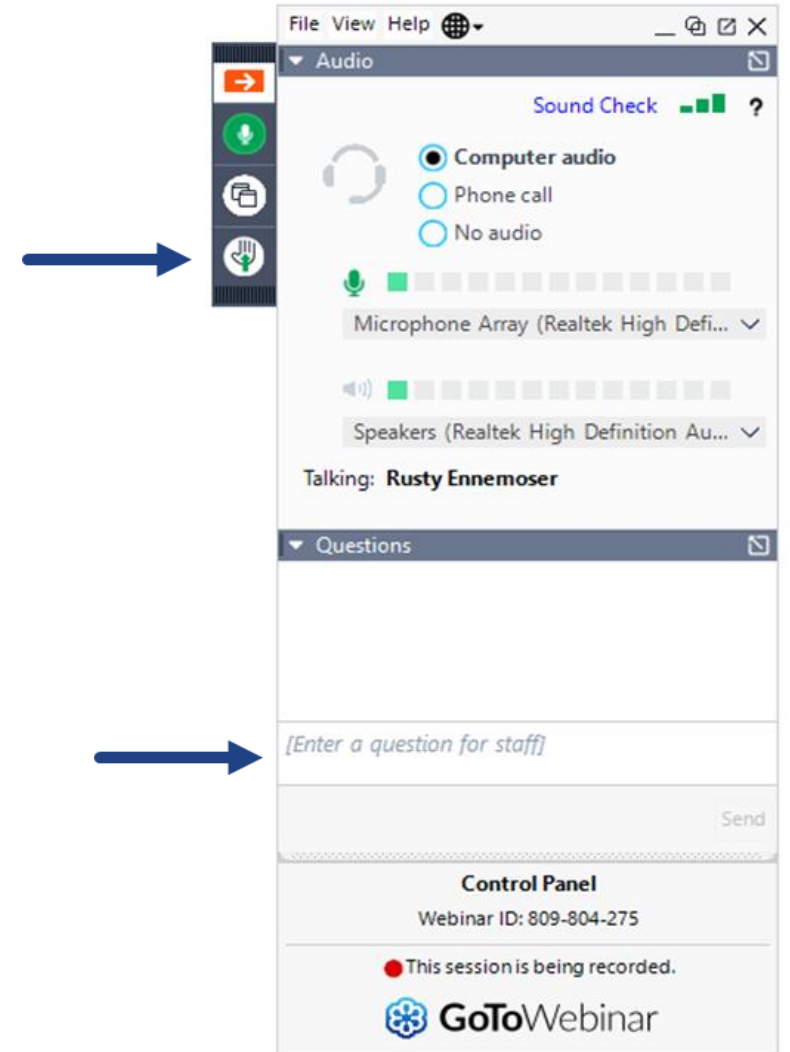
