Upgrade pedestrian signals at 7 Avenue N., 10 Avenue N., and 13 Avenue N. to countdown signals

Install Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) and crosswalks at the north side of 6 Avenue N.

Install raised intersection at 16 Avenue N.

Install speed feedback signs near the curves at Wellesley Drive

Retrofit lighting at pedestrian crosswalks at signalized intersections











- Non-compliant and damaged curb ramps will be upgraded along the existing sidewalk.
- High emphasis pedestrian crosswalks will be added to all signalized intersections.

Lighting and Signalization Improvements




Lighting retrofits at existing signalized intersections to improve visibility.


