BRANT DRIVE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House both in person and virtually regarding bridge and roadway improvements on Brant Drive from Oregon Lane to Avocet Road in the cities of Boca Raton and Delray Beach. Participants may attend in person or online. Representatives will be available to provide information and answer questions. Project documents will be available at the meeting and at d4fdot.com/pbfdot/.

The City of Delray Beach, as the Project Sponsor, requested through the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) and City of Delray Beach Resolution 04-18 that FDOT District Four design and construct the Brant Drive Bridge Replacement Project. FDOT is pleased to assist the cities and Palm Beach TPA in delivering their vision and providing the following information on this bridge replacement project.

Construction Cost: \$2,472,960

Construction Start Date: August 2, 2021

Anticipated Completion: Late 2022

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Replacing the two-lane Brant Drive Bridge (Bridge No. 935501) over the C-15 Canal with a new bridge consisting of two travel lanes and 10-foot shared-use paths in each direction
- Constructing 10-foot shared-use paths in each direction north of the bridge
- Reconstructing sidewalks south of the bridge
- Adding decorative lighting and drainage
- Upgrading signage and pavement markings
- Reconstructing roadway approaches and milling and resurfacing

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- A full bridge closure will occur for the duration of construction. Traffic will be detoured to North Dixie Highway via Hidden Valley Boulevard and Lindell Boulevard.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
- Navigation of the canal will be maintained for marine traffic.


