The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), is pleased to provide information for the Advanced Transportation Management System project in the City of Boca Raton.

Construction Cost: \$3.6 Million

Construction Start: July 2023

Estimated Completion: Summer 2024

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Installing a new fiber optic network
- Installing Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) devices including Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) cameras controlled by wireless network devices
- Installing Bluetooth travel time devices on US 1 from Royal Palm Way to Spanish River Boulevard
- Upgrading the signal system detection to include pedestrian/bicycle detection
- Upgrading the Advanced Traffic Management System (ATMS) for compatibility with the Traffic Management Center (TMC)

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- Single lane closures are allowed nightly Monday through Sunday at the following locations:
 - SR 5/US 1 from 10:00 p.m. until 6:30 a.m.
 - SR 794/Yamato Road from 11:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.
- Nighttime intersection detours will be required to install Bluetooth travel time devices; advanced notice will be provided with motorist and pedestrian detours clearly marked
- Access to businesses, residences, driveways, and bus stops will be maintained at all times

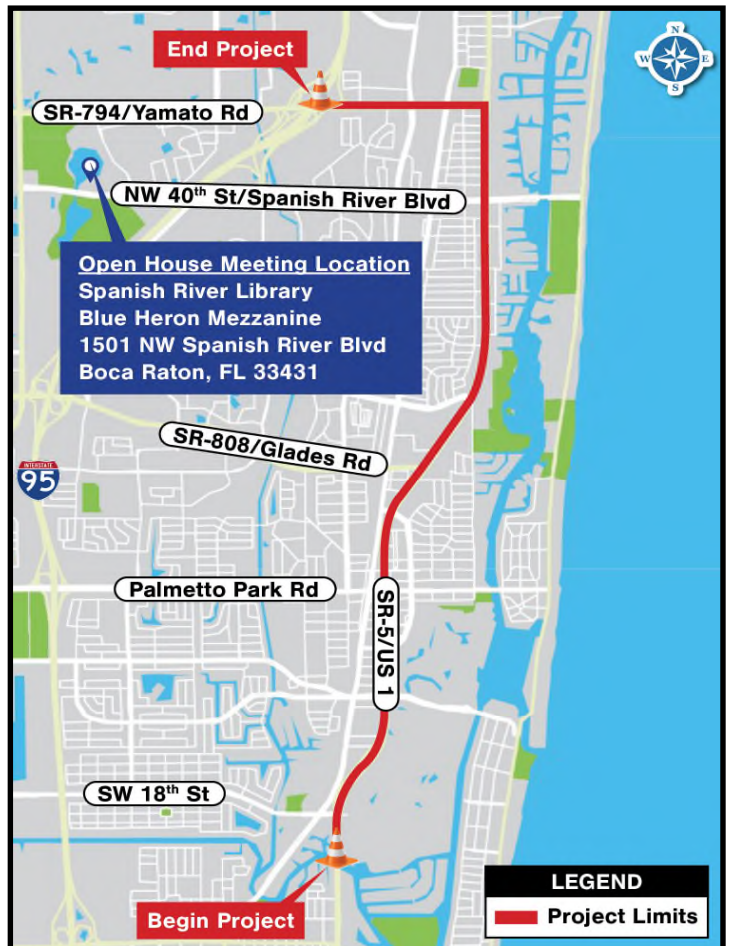
