SR 9/I-95 NB OFF-RAMP AT SR 706/INDIANTOWN ROAD—JULY/AUGUST 2024 PROGRESS REPORT

Thursday, Aug. 1, 2024 marks day 277 of 600, with work 46% completed. The project is currently on schedule for completion in Summer 2025. Weekly lane closure updates, project progress photos and additional information can be found on the <u>project webpage</u>.

WORK PERFORMED IN JULY 2024

- Installation of beams and deck forms for bridge widening on the outside lanes of Indiantown Road over the C-18 canal (just west of Island Way) in the eastbound and westbound directions
- Structural asphalt paving on the I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Indiantown Road and along eastbound Indiantown Road, as well as shoulder widening operations
- Directional boring operations for future signal and lighting installation on Indiantown Road at the Island Way and 68th Terrace N. intersection
- Drainage installation on eastbound Indiantown Road east of Island Way

ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES FOR AUGUST 2024

- Installation of reinforcing steel followed by concrete bridge deck pouring operations on the outside lanes of Indiantown Road over the C-18 canal (just west of Island Way) in the eastbound and westbound directions
- Drilled shaft installation for overhead signage structures
- Restriping westbound Indiantown Road to shift westbound traffic towards the median to allow for work on the shoulder
- Curb, gutter and sidewalk installation on eastbound then westbound Indiantown Road

FULL NIGHTLY RAMP CLOSURES PLANNED FOR AUGUST 11 & 12

- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Indiantown Road will undergo a full closure, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday night, Aug. 11, for striping activities. Motorists will be detoured via eastbound Indiantown Road to U-turn at the Island Way intersection. If inclement weather delays operations, work will take place the following night.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Indiantown Road will undergo a full closure, 10 p.m. until 6 a.m., Monday night, Aug. 12, for striping activities. Motorists will be detoured via the SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound Indiantown Road. If inclement weather delays operations, work will take place the following night.

RAMP IMPACTS

• The I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Indiantown Road will have one lane closed around-the-clock through September 2024.
