- Milling and resurfacing the existing roadway
- Improving signing and pavement markings
- Upgrading pedestrian curb ramps to meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- Upgrading lighting and signalization at the following intersections:
 - Weisman Way/Bella Terra Way
 - Belvedere Road
 - Business Park Way
 - Regal Cinemas 18
 - Aldi Way
 - SR 704/Okeechobee Boulevard

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Construction will occur in phases to minimize impacts to the public
- Single-lane closures are permitted Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. and nightly, Sun-day through Thursday, from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. and from 8:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. for striping operations
- Double-lane closures are permitted nightly, Sunday through Thursday, from 9:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. during milling and resurfacing activities, except during special events
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk closures as needed
- Direct coordination with Palm Beach County Mass Transit to mitigate impacts to existing bus stops throughout construction
- Pedestrian, driveway and street access will be maintained at all times
