I-95 NORTHBOUND AT 6TH AVENUE SOUTH TO UNDERGO FULL NIGHTLY CLOSURE AUG. 28

All I-95 northbound lanes at 6th Avenue South will be closed to traffic overnight, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Monday, Aug. 28 for overhead sign structure installation. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. During this operation, I-95 northbound traffic will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp to 6th Avenue South, US 1 North and the 10th Avenue North I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Westbound 6th Avenue South motorists will be detoured to US 1 via u-turn. Tuesday, Aug. 29 will be used as a contingency night if needed. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.



I-95 Safety Improvements Project consists of milling and resurfacing segments of I-95 in both directions, installing new signage, including an overhead Dynamic Message Sign on I-95 northbound just south of 10th Avenue North, upgrading existing lighting with LED luminaires and installing a new Road Weather Information System (RWIS).
