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### DRAINAGE INSTALLATION BETWEEN NE 3RD AVENUE AND US 1 TO BEGIN SEPT. 13, 2021

- **George Bush Boulevard, between NE 3rd Avenue and US 1, will be closed around-the-clock for drainage installation beginning Monday, Sept. 13, 2021 through Saturday, Oct. 2, 2021**
- Detour routes will be marked along NE 2nd Avenue, NE 9th Terrace, NE 3rd Avenue, US 1, and NE 6th Avenue, as noted on the detour map provided
- Please note, work activities are only performed during daytime hours, Monday through Saturday:
  - Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.
  - Saturday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- During this time, the City of Delray Beach will also be performing utility repairs in this location
- Emergency vehicle, local driveway and pedestrian access will be provided at all times

### PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Milling and resurfacing the roadway with minor widening; drainage and utility improvements
- Concrete sidewalk and driveway replacement, new sidewalk connections, and curb and gutter improvements
- Signing and pavement marking upgrades, including bike lane and detectable warning surfaces

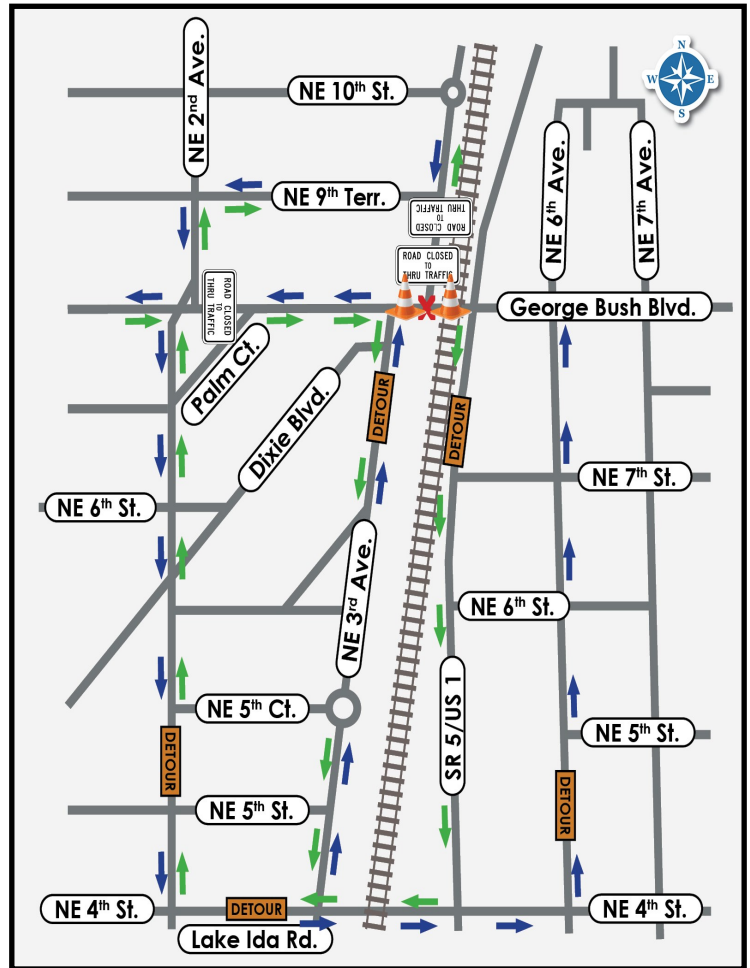
