PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

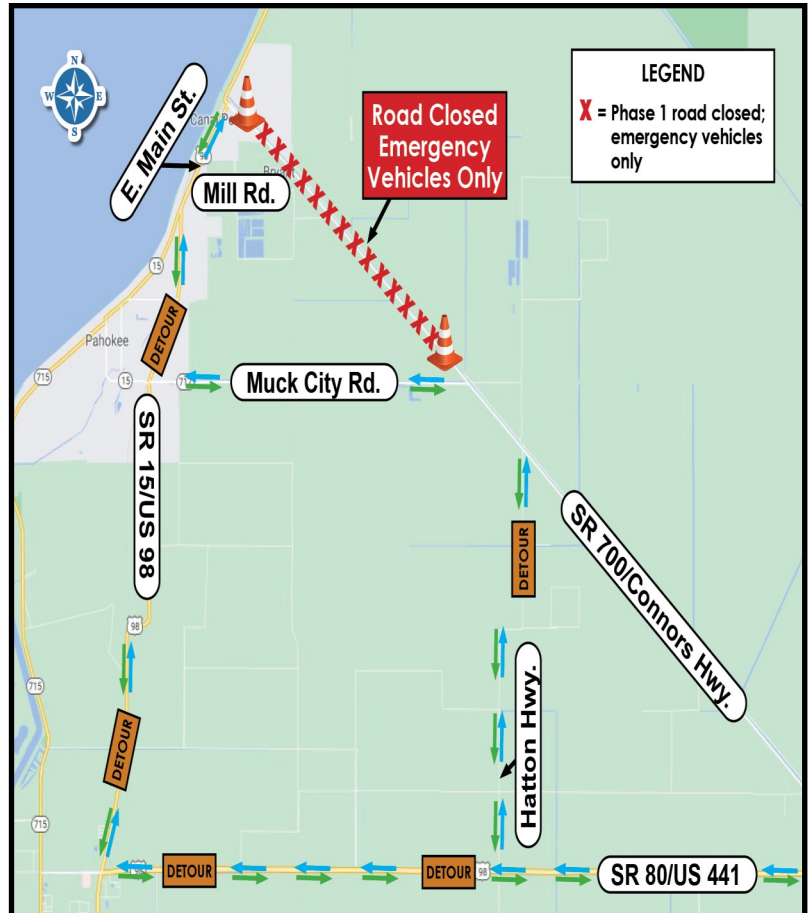
- Embankment repairs at SR 700 and the L-10 Canal, including: Bank stabilization and re-vetments, guardrail replacement, signing and pavement markings, and signalization replacement.
