INDIAN TRAIL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TRAFFIC CALMING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, is pleased to provide information regarding traffic calming improvements on the following roadways in unincorporated Palm Beach County: Hall Boulevard from north of 72nd Court to north of Temple Boulevard, Temple Boulevard from west of Hall Boulevard to west of 140th Avenue North, and 140th Avenue North from north of 71st Place North to north of 82nd Street North.

As the project sponsor, the Indian Trail Improvement District requested through the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) and Indian Trail Improvement District Resolution 2017-17 that FDOT District Four design and construct traffic calming enhancements on the referenced district roadways. FDOT is pleased to assist the district and Palm Beach TPA in delivering their vision and providing the following information on this project.

Construction Cost: \$928,650 Construction Start: October 2022 Anticipated Completion: Spring 2023

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Constructing a raised median with minor roadway widening at the intersection of Hall Boulevard and Temple Boulevard
- Constructing two speed tables along Temple Boulevard
- Installing six mid-block raised islands with minor roadway widening along Hall Boulevard and 140th Avenue North
- Constructing asphalt sidewalks in select locations
- Upgrading pavement markings, signage and rumble strips

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

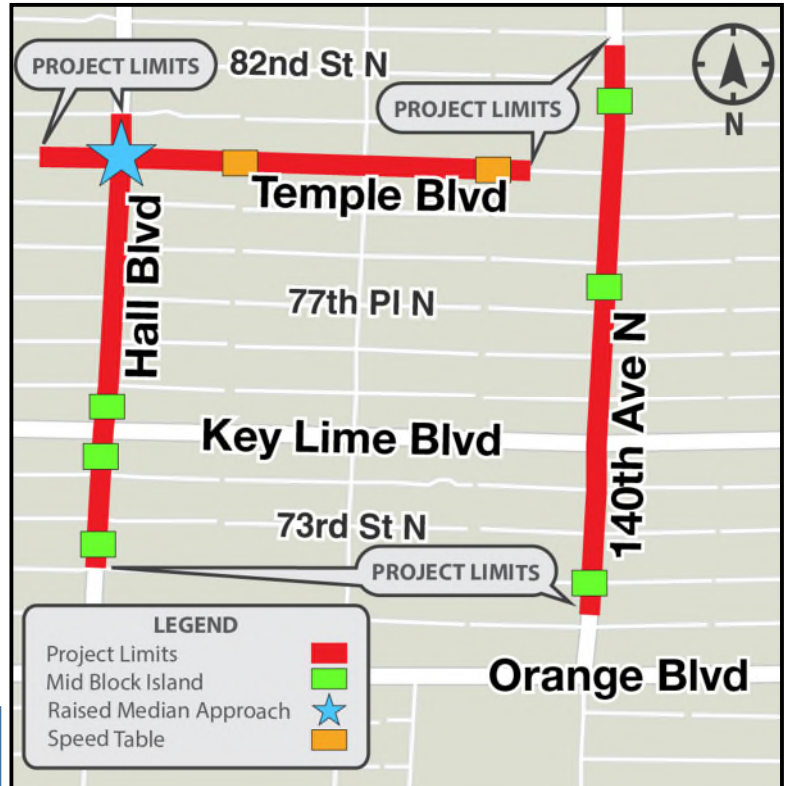
- Lane closures may occur from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday with traffic personnel directing traffic.
- Pedestrian detours will be in place during sidewalk closures.
- Access to adjacent properties will be maintained.
