SR 729/State Market Road to Undergo Full Closure for Road Construction, September 9 — December 23, 2024

Construction Cost: \$4.9 million

Construction Start: April 28, 2024

Anticipated Completion: Spring 2025

ROAD CONSTRUCTION WORK ON SR 729/STATE MARKET ROAD FROM LARRIMORE ROAD TO SR 15/E MAIN STREET

- Beginning 12:00 p.m., Monday afternoon, Sept. 9, SR 729/State Market Road from Larrimore Road to SR 15/E Main Street will be closed, around-the-clock, through approximately 5 p.m., Monday, December 23, 2024, for road construction work
- Northbound SR 729/State Market Road will be detoured via S. Lake Avenue and SR 15/E Main Street
- Southbound SR 729/State Market Road will be detoured via SR 15/E Main Street and S. Lake Avenue
- Local traffic access for emergency vehicles, residents and businesses will be maintained

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Mill and resurface SR 729/State Market Road to ensure long-term resilience
- Widen traffic lanes from 11 feet to 12 feet to accommodate the high volume of truck traffic
- Widen the existing paved shoulders as permitted by FDOT right-of-way to improve safety within the corridor
- Reconstruct northbound SR 729/State Market Road sidewalks and shared use paths from north of Rock Pit Road to SR 15/US 441/E Main Street for pedestrian safety
- Upgrade signage and pavement markings throughout project limits for motorist safety
