The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will conduct a Public Meeting regarding the proposed roadway improvements along SR 802/Lake Worth Road and Lake Osborne Road, in Lake Worth Beach, Florida. This Public Meeting will be offered in two different formats: virtual and in-person. The Public Meeting will have representatives available to answer questions. PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Adding a sidewalk along Lake Osborne Road
- Adding a pedestrian mid-block crossing along SR 802/Lake Worth Road, west of Erie Street
- Upgrading Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) pedestrian signals to meet current standards
- Roundabout pedestrian improvements at SR 802/Lake Worth Road and east of south B Street
- Lighting improvements along SR 802/Lake Worth Road

CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- All work will be done in phases to reduce the impact of construction to the community
- All lane closures will occur during non-peak hours
- No full roadway closures will occur
- Access to businesses and residents will be maintained at all times during construction

- Anticipated Completion: **January 2023**
- Construction Cost Estimate: **\$1 Million**

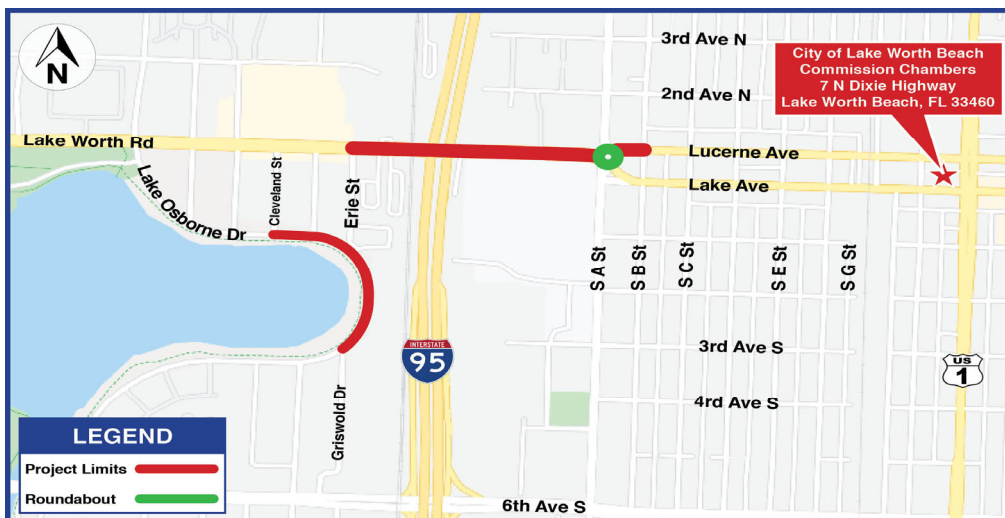
