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FDOT Palm Beach County Traffic Report January 27 through February 3, 2023

PALM BEACH COUNTY, Fla. – Palm Beach County traffic will be affected this week by ongoing construction projects and maintenance work, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) officials report. Closures will be in effect on I-95 and in other areas throughout Palm Beach County for construction activities. Please note, that any full road, ramp, or bridge closures have been highlighted below.

CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

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INTERSTATE 95

1. **I-95 from south of Glades Road to south of Linton Boulevard and SR 808/Glades Road from NW 22nd Way to West University Drive in the Cities of Boca Raton and Delray Beach (95 Express Phase 3B-2)**

DESCRIPTION: 95 Express Lanes Phase 3B-2 will extend the existing Express Lanes north from just south of Glades Road to just south of Linton Boulevard in Palm Beach County. One lane will be added, and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Access to the Express Lanes will be provided via two designated ingress and egress locations—between Glades Road and Congress Avenue. The scope of work includes reconfiguration of the SR 808/Glades Road Interchange to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). Additional project improvements include overhead sign structure installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and Express Lane markers, new signalization, lighting, signing and pavement markings, and ramp signalization at five interchanges from Glades Road to Linton Boulevard. Shoulder-mounted sound barrier walls will be constructed along I-95 northbound between Clint Moore Road and Linton Boulevard, ground-mounted sound walls will be installed on the south side of Yamato Road east of I-95 adjacent to the University Heights Community and along I-95 northbound south of Linton Boulevard adjacent to the Tierra Verde Community. The Clint Moore Road Bridge over I-95 will be fully reconstructed and the Glades Road bridge over the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) railroad tracks and Military Trail and the I-95 bridge over the C-15 Canal (between Peninsula Drive and Linton Boulevard) will be widened. Cost/Completion: \$148 million. Completion is expected in late 2023.

I-95 Traffic Impact:

- I-95 will have up to four lanes closed in each direction nightly, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third and fourth lane will close at 11 p.m.
- I-95 southbound from Spanish River Road to Glades Road is in a new traffic pattern with traffic shifted to the outside to allow for median construction, through January 2023.
- **I-95 Northbound Full Closure Notice:** All I-95 southbound lanes at SR-794/Yamato Road will be closed to traffic overnight, Tuesday, Jan. 31 for overhead sign structure installation. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 10 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. each morning. Traffic will be detoured via the southbound exit ramp to SR-794/Yamato Road, [SR-809/Military Trail](#) and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists. Wednesday, Feb. 1 will be used as a contingency night if needed.
- **I-95 Southbound Full Closure Advanced Notice:** All I-95 southbound lanes at Congress Avenue will be closed to traffic overnight, Wednesday, Feb. 8 for overhead sign structure installation. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 10 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 southbound exit ramp to Congress Avenue, Congress Avenue and SR-794/Yamato Road. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists. Thursday, Feb. 9 will be used as a contingency night if needed. Please see the detour flyer attached.
- **All access to and from SR-808/Glades Road at I-95 will be restricted for the implementation of the Diverging Diamond Interchange, 11 p.m., Friday, Jan. 27 through 6 a.m., Monday, Jan. 30.** The Glades Road/I-95 interchange will reopen in the new Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) configuration at 6 a.m., Monday morning, Jan. 30. Military Trail Impact:

Ramp Impact:

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Glades Road, Jog Road, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Spanish River Boulevard will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 north, Yamato Road east, US-1, and Spanish River Boulevard. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Congress Avenue and Peninsula Corp. Drive will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via southbound I-95 and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Traffic will be detoured via eastbound Yamato Road, US-1/Federal Highway south, westbound Glades Road, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Glades Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Yamato Road, Congress Ave, Peninsula Corp Drive, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Peninsula Corp Drive. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via [westbound](#) Glades Road, Powerline Road, and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Peninsula Corp Drive will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

Clint Moore Road Impact:

- One inside lane in each direction and the westbound outside lane are open to vehicular traffic. To ensure public safety, the eastbound outside lane remains closed during drainage installation operations.

Yamato Road Impact:

- Eastbound Yamato Road at I-95 will have one outside lane closed as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Westbound Yamato Road at I-95 will have one outside lane closed as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday.

2. I-95 from south of 10th Avenue N. to North of SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard Safety Improvements Project

Description: This 2.75-mile project located in West Palm Beach and Lake Worth Beach began on August 10, 2022. Improvements include milling and resurfacing segments of I-95 in both directions, installing new signage, including an overhead Dynamic Message Sign on I-95 northbound just south of 10th Avenue North, upgrading existing lighting with LED luminaires and installing a new Road Weather Information System (RWIS).

Cost/Completion: \$3.4 million/Fall 2023

Traffic Impact:

- I-95 between Lake Worth Road and Forest Hill Boulevard will have one southbound lane closed nightly, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, Jan. 29, through Thursday, Feb. 2, to install luminaires.
- I-95 between Lake Worth Road and 10th Avenue North may have one northbound outside lane and shoulder closed overnight, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, Jan. 30, and Tuesday, Jan. 31, to install foundations for overhead signage.
- I-95 between Lake Worth Road and 10th Avenue North may have a northbound shoulder closed 7 a.m. to 10 a.m., Tuesday, Jan. 31, to install foundations for overhead signage.
- I-95 between Lake Worth Road and 10th Avenue North may have a northbound outside lane and shoulder closed, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 31, and Wednesday, Feb. 1, to install foundations for overhead signage. 3. SR 9/I-95 at SR 786/PGA Boulevard Southbound Entrance Ramps Project

Description: This 0.65-mile project in Palm Beach Gardens began on November 9, 2022. Improvements consist of reconfiguring the I-95 southbound entrance ramps at PGA Boulevard. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound PGA Boulevard to southbound I-95 will be converted from a merge lane to an additional, free-flowing lane. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound PGA Boulevard to southbound I-95 will be reconfigured to become a merge lane. In addition, I-95 will be widened between PGA Boulevard and Burns Road, and lighting, drainage, signage and pavement markings will be upgraded.

Cost/Completion: \$9,977,382/Spring 2024

Traffic Impact:

- I-95 southbound between PGA Boulevard and Burns Road may have three lanes closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, Jan. 29, through Saturday, Feb. 4, to install barrier wall and striping.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramps from eastbound and westbound PGA Boulevard may be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, Jan. 29, through Saturday, Feb. 4, to install barrier wall

and striping.

- **Advance notice:** The I-95 southbound entrance ramps from eastbound and westbound PGA Boulevard may be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, Feb. 5, through Saturday, Feb. 11, to install barrier wall and striping. SOUTHERN PALM BEACH COUNTY PROJECTS (Boca Raton, Delray Beach)

4. Brant Drive Bridge Replacement Project

Description: This 0.1-mile project in the cities of Boca Raton and Delray Beach consists of replacing the two-lane Brant Drive Bridge (Bridge No. 935501) over the C-15 Canal with a new bridge consisting of two travel lanes and 10-foot shared-use paths in each direction. Improvements also include constructing 10-foot shared-use paths in each direction north of the bridge, reconstructing sidewalks south of the bridge, adding decorative lighting and drainage, upgrading signage and pavement markings, reconstructing roadway approaches, and milling and resurfacing.

Cost/Completion: \$2.47 million/Early 2023

Traffic Impact:

- Brant Drive is closed from Oregon Lane to Avocet Road for the duration of construction. Traffic will be detoured as follows:
 - Northbound traffic should go south on Brant Drive to East Country Club Boulevard, go south on East Country Club Boulevard to West Hidden Valley Boulevard, go east on West Hidden Valley Boulevard to North Dixie Highway, go north on North Dixie Highway to Lindell Boulevard, go west on Lindell Boulevard to Carl Bolter Drive, go south on Carl Bolter Drive to Brant Drive.
 - Southbound traffic should go north on Brant Drive to Carl Bolter Drive, go north on Carl Bolter Drive to Lindell Boulevard, go east on Lindell Boulevard to North Dixie Highway, go south on North Dixie Highway to West Hidden Valley Boulevard, go west on West Hidden Valley Boulevard to East Country Club Boulevard, go north on East Country Club Boulevard to Brant Drive.

5. George Bush Boulevard Improvements Project

Description: This 0.8-mile roadway improvements project, from NE 2nd Avenue to State Road A1A in the City of Delray Beach, began Monday, July 19, 2021. The City of Delray Beach, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four design and construct this project through application to the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency and City of Delray Beach Resolution 06-18. Work includes milling and resurfacing with minor widening, concrete sidewalk

and driveway replacement, including curb and gutter improvements, signing and pavement marking upgrades, including bike lane and detectable warning surfaces, and drainage and utility improvements.

Cost/Completion: \$2 million. Completion is expected in summer 2023.

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of George Bush Boulevard from just east of the George Bush Blvd ICW Drawbridge to SR A1A may be closed Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., for curb and gutter, sidewalk work, and paving. During this time, a flagging operation will be used to direct traffic eastbound and westbound as needed. Emergency vehicles, local driveway, and pedestrian access will be provided at all times. 6. Homewood Boulevard Improvements Project

Description: This 0.8-mile roadway improvements project from Old Germantown Road to Lawson Boulevard in the City of Delray Beach began Friday, November 12, 2021. The City of Delray Beach, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four design and construct the Homewood Boulevard Improvements Project through application to the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency, Palm Beach County Resolution 2021-0169, and City of Delray Beach Resolution 06-18. Work includes milling and resurfacing the roadway with minor widening; concrete sidewalk and driveway replacement, including curb and gutter improvements; signing and pavement marking upgrades, including bike lane and detectable warning surfaces; installation of four (4) new signal mast arms at Linton Blvd. to meet current standards; and drainage and utility improvements.

Cost/Completion: \$2.5 million. Completion is expected in early 2023.

Traffic Impact:

- The outside eastbound lane of Linton Boulevard at the intersection of Homewood Boulevard, will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, Jan. 30 through Friday, Feb. 3, as needed, for signalization and sidewalk work.
- The outside westbound lane of Linton Boulevard at the intersection of Homewood Boulevard, will be closed daily from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Jan. 30 through Friday, Feb. 3, as needed, for signalization and sidewalk work.
- One lane in either direction of Homewood Boulevard from Old Germantown Road to Lawson Boulevard will be closed daily 9 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday, Jan. 30 through Friday, Feb. 3, as needed, for paving operations. Two-way traffic will be maintained with a flagging operation.
- Two lanes in either direction of Linton Boulevard at the intersection of Homewood Boulevard will be closed nightly, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, Jan. 29 through Wednesday, Feb. 1. For paving operations. Traffic will be maintained by a flagging operation as needed. 7. SR 802/Lake Worth Road Improvements Project

Description: This 1.90-mile project from Raulerson Drive to Palm Beach State College Entrance/Douglas Drive in the city of Lake Worth Beach began on Monday, November 14, 2022. Work includes constructing a new exclusive right turn lane from eastbound Lake Worth Road into the Mid-County Senior Center, installing new seven-foot bike lanes with upgraded safety features, milling and resurfacing Lake Worth Road in both directions, replacing underground Palm Beach County utilities throughout the project limits, improving sidewalk and driveways on both sides of Lake Worth Road, modifying medians to improve motorist safety, improving signalized intersections and pedestrian crossings, and installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting.

Cost/Completion: \$14 million. Completion is expected in winter 2024.

Traffic Impacts:

- The outside eastbound lane on Lake Worth Road from Foss Road to Coconut Road is closed for turn lane construction.
- The inside eastbound lane on Lake Worth Road between Urquhart Street to Kirk Road is closed for force main installation.
- The inside westbound lane on Lake Worth Road from just east of Kirk Road to Urquhart Street is closed for force main installation.
- The two inside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road between Raulerson Drive and S. Price Street will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, Jan. 29 for force main installation.
- The two outside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road between Raulerson Drive and S. Price Street will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, Jan. 30 for force main installation.
- The two inside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road between Raulerson Drive and S. 42nd Way will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, Jan. 31 for force main installation.
- The two outside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road between Raulerson Drive and S. 42nd Way will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday, Feb. 1 for force main installation.
- The two inside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road between S. Price Street and Cooley Court will be closed from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Thursday, Feb. 2 for force main installation.
- **Advance Notice:** Beginning 9 p.m., Sunday, Feb. 19, 2023, northbound and southbound Military Trail at Lake Worth Road will be closed through 6 a.m. Monday, Feb. 20, 2023 for installation of the force main. 8. US-1/SR-805 Lighting and Signalization Improvements Project

Description: This 0.400-mile project began on Thursday, August 11, 2022. Work includes installing new steel mast arms at the intersections of US-1/Lake Avenue and US-1/Lucerne Avenue, installing new light poles with LED Luminaires, replacing concrete sidewalk, driveways, and curb and gutter impacted by LED light pole installation, signing, and pavement marking upgrades, including detectable warning surfaces, improving intersection street lighting and pedestrian signalization.

Cost/Completion: \$1 million. Completion is expected in Spring 2023.

Traffic Impact:

- The right lane of northbound Dixie Highway and the right lane of eastbound Lake Avenue may be closed 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday, Jan. 30 for directional bore operations.

- The right lane of southbound Dixie Highway and the right lane of eastbound Lake Avenue may be closed 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 31 for directional bore operations.
- The right lane of northbound Dixie Highway and the right lane of eastbound Lake Avenue may be closed 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Wednesday, Feb. 1 for directional bore operations.
- The right lane of southbound Dixie Highway may be closed 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Thursday, Feb. 2 for directional bore operations.
