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### **FDOT Palm Beach County Traffic Report** May 26 – June 2, 2023

**PALM BEACH COUNTY, Fla.** – Palm Beach County traffic will be affected this week by ongoing construction projects and maintenance work, Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) officials report. Closures will be in effect on I-95 and in other areas throughout Palm Beach County for construction activities. Please note, that any full road, ramp, or bridge closures have been highlighted below.

#### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

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#### **INTERSTATE 95**

1. **I-95 from south of Glades Road to south of Linton Boulevard and SR 808/Glades Road from NW 22<sup>nd</sup> Way to West University Drive in the Cities of Boca Raton and Delray Beach (95 Express Phase 3B-2)**

**Description:** 95 Express Lanes Phase 3B-2 will extend the existing Express Lanes north from just south of Glades Road to just south of Linton Boulevard in Palm Beach County. One lane will be added,

and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of General Use lanes will remain the same. Access to the Express Lanes will be provided via two designated ingress and egress locations—between Glades Road and Congress Avenue. The scope of work includes reconfiguration of the SR 808/Glades Road Interchange to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). Additional project improvements include overhead sign structure installation, Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and Express Lane markers, new signalization, lighting, signing and pavement markings, and ramp signalization at five interchanges from Glades Road to Linton Boulevard. Shoulder-mounted sound barrier walls will be constructed along I-95 northbound between Clint Moore Road and Linton Boulevard, ground-mounted sound walls will be installed on the south side of Yamato Road east of I-95 adjacent to the University Heights Community and along I-95 northbound south of Linton Boulevard adjacent to the Tierra Verde Community. The Clint Moore Road Bridge over I-95 will be fully reconstructed and the Glades Road bridge over the South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) railroad tracks and Military Trail and the I-95 bridge over the C-15 Canal (between Peninsula Drive and Linton Boulevard) will be widened. Cost/Completion: \$148 million. Completion is expected in late 2023.

### **I-95 Traffic Impact:**

- I-95 will have up to four lanes closed in each direction nightly, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third and fourth lane will close at 11 p.m.
- The southbound express lanes at the Spanish River Boulevard egress point will be closed to traffic, 10 p.m., Friday night, June 2 until 5 a.m., Monday, June 5 for final paving, striping and tubular marker installation.
- I-95 southbound between Glades Road and Palmetto Park Road will have the express lanes and one inside general use lanes closed for final paving, striping and tubular marker installation, 11 p.m. Friday night, June 2 until 5 a.m., Monday, June 5. Two general use lanes and the auxiliary lane will remain open during this operation.
- **I-95 Northbound Full Closure Notice:** All I-95 northbound lanes at Congress Avenue will be closed to traffic overnight, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Thursday, June 1 for overhead sign structure operations. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 10 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via the I-95 northbound exit ramp to Peninsula Corp Drive/Congress Avenue, Congress Avenue and Linton Boulevard. During this operation, eastbound Peninsula Corp Drive to I-95 northbound traffic will be detoured to I-95 northbound via Congress Avenue and Linton Boulevard. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists. Monday, June 5 will be used as a contingency night if needed.

### **Glades Road Impact:**

- The SR-808/Glades Road and I-95 interchange is in a new Diverging Diamond configuration. Please use caution as you approach the interchange – the posted speed is 35 MPH. Keep the crossover intersections clear like you would on any other roadway.
- One eastbound and westbound lane of the DDI will be closed, as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, for grading and sod placement.
- Westbound Glades Road, between St. Andrews Blvd and University Drive/FAU Blvd, will have one lane closed daily, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Monday through Friday and from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday.
- Eastbound Glades Road, between St. Andrews Boulevard and University Drive/FAU Blvd, will have one lane closed daily, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Tuesday through Friday and from 9 p.m. until

6 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday.

### **Military Trail Impact:**

- No impacts anticipated.

### **Ramp Impact:**

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Glades Road, Jog Road, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from eastbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound Glades Road, N Federal Highway, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Glades Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Glades Road, Powerline Road, and Palmetto Park Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance from eastbound Glades Road will be closed as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound [Glades Road, US-1/Federal Highway](#) and Palmetto Park Road.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Spanish River Boulevard will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 north, Yamato Road east, N Federal Highway, and Spanish River Boulevard. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Congress Avenue and Peninsula Corp. Drive will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via southbound I-95 and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Congress Avenue will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Linton Boulevard. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue/Peninsula Corp Drive, Congress Avenue, and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Yamato Road/Spanish River Blvd will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Peninsula Corp Dr, Congress Ave. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound Yamato Road, US-1/Federal Highway south, westbound Glades Road, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Glades Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Yamato Road will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via westbound Yamato Road, Congress Ave, Peninsula Corp Drive, and the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Peninsula Corp Drive. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.
- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Peninsula Corp Drive will be closed nightly as needed, 11 p.m. until 5 a.m., Tuesday through Thursday. Traffic will be detoured via Congress Avenue and Yamato Road. FHP will be on site to assist motorists.

### **Clint Moore Road Impact:**

- One inside lane in each direction and the westbound outside lane are open to vehicular traffic. To ensure public safety, the eastbound outside lane remains closed during drainage installation operations.

- To ensure pedestrian safety during drainage activities, the south sidewalk of Clint Moore Road from Congress Avenue to NW 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue is closed through June 15, 2023. Pedestrian traffic is being detoured to the north sidewalk during this phase of construction.

#### **Yamato Road Impact:**

- Eastbound Yamato Road at I-95 will have one outside lane closed as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Tuesday through Friday.
- Westbound Yamato Road at I-95 will have one outside lane closed as needed, 9:30 a.m. until 4 p.m., Tuesday through Friday.

### **2. I-95 from south of 10th Avenue North to north of SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard Safety Improvements Project**

**Description:** This 2.75-mile project located in West Palm Beach and Lake Worth Beach began on August 10, 2022. Improvements include milling and resurfacing segments of I-95 in both directions, installing new signage, including an overhead Dynamic Message Sign on I-95 northbound just south of 10th Avenue North, upgrading existing lighting with LED luminaires and installing a new Road Weather Information System (RWIS).

**Cost/Completion:** \$3.4 million/Fall 2023

#### **Traffic Impact:**

- I-95 at 10th Avenue North may have one lane in both directions closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, May 30, through Thursday, June 1, to install underdeck lighting.
- I-95 between Forest Hill Boulevard and 10th Avenue North may have one inside lane in either direction closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, May 30, through Thursday, June 1, for inside shoulder milling and resurfacing operations.
- I-95 between Forest Hill Boulevard and 10th Avenue North may have one outside lane in either direction closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, May 30, through Thursday, June 1, for outside shoulder milling and resurfacing operations.
- 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue North under I-95 will have one lane in either direction closed nightly from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Tuesday, May 30, through Thursday, June 1, to install underdeck lighting. ### **3. SR 9/I-95 at SR 786/PGA Boulevard Southbound Entrance Ramps Project**

**Description:** This 0.65-mile project in Palm Beach Gardens began on November 9, 2022. Improvements consist of reconfiguring the I-95 southbound entrance ramps at PGA Boulevard. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound PGA Boulevard to southbound I-95 will be converted from a merge lane to an additional, free-flowing lane. The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound PGA Boulevard to southbound I-95 will be reconfigured to become a merge lane. In addition, I-95 will be widened between PGA Boulevard and Burns Road, and lighting, drainage, signage and pavement markings will be upgraded.

**Cost/Completion:** \$9,977,382/Spring 2024

#### **Traffic Impact:**

- The I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound PGA Boulevard may be closed nightly between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., Tuesday, May 30, through Friday, June 23, for roadway construction and paving operations. Traffic will be detoured to Northlake Boulevard's I-95 entrance ramps via Military Trail. ## **SOUTHERN PALM BEACH COUNTY PROJECTS** **(Boca Raton, Delray Beach)**

### **4. George Bush Boulevard Improvements Project**

**Description:** This 0.8-mile roadway improvements project, from NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to State Road A1A in the City of Delray Beach, began Monday, July 19, 2021. The City of Delray Beach, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four design and construct this project through application to the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency and City of Delray Beach Resolution 06-18. Work includes milling and resurfacing with minor widening, concrete sidewalk, and driveway replacement, including curb and gutter improvements, signing and pavement marking upgrades, including bike lane and detectable warning surfaces, and drainage and utility improvements.

**Cost/Completion:** \$2 million. Completion is expected in summer 2023.

#### **Traffic Impact:**

- One lane in each direction of George Bush Boulevard from NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to State Road A1A/N Ocean Boulevard will undergo a rolling lane closure Wednesday, May 31, from 11 p.m. until 7 a.m. for striping operations. Flagging operations will be in place to direct eastbound and westbound traffic as needed.
- One lane in each direction of George Bush Boulevard from NE 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue to State Road A1A/N Ocean Boulevard may be closed from 7 a.m. until 6 a.m., Wednesday through Friday. A flagging operation will direct eastbound and westbound traffic as needed. Emergency vehicles, local driveway, and pedestrian access will be provided at all times. ### **5. Homewood Boulevard Improvements Project**

**Description:** This 0.8-mile roadway improvements project from Old Germantown Road to Lawson Boulevard in the City of Delray Beach began Friday, November 12, 2021. The City of Delray Beach, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District Four design and construct the Homewood Boulevard Improvements Project through application to the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency, Palm Beach County Resolution 2021-0169, and City of Delray Beach Resolution 06-18. Work includes milling and resurfacing the roadway with minor widening; concrete sidewalk and driveway replacement, including curb and gutter improvements; signing and pavement marking upgrades, including bike lane and detectable warning surfaces; installation of four (4) new signal mast arms at Linton Blvd. to meet current standards; and drainage and utility improvements.

**Cost/Completion:** \$2.5 million. Completion is expected in early 2023.

**CENTRAL PALM BEACH COUNTY PROJECTS**

**(Boynton Beach, Lantana, Lake Worth Beach, The Acreage, West Palm Beach, Palm Beach)**

**6. SR 802/Lake Worth Road Improvements Project**

**Description:** This 1.90-mile project from Raulerson Drive to Palm Beach State College Entrance/Douglas Drive in the city of Lake Worth Beach began on Monday, November 14, 2022. Work includes constructing a new exclusive right turn lane from eastbound Lake Worth Road into the Mid-County Senior Center, installing new seven-foot bike lanes with upgraded safety features, milling and resurfacing Lake Worth Road in both directions, replacing underground Palm Beach County utilities throughout the project limits, improving sidewalk and driveways on both sides of Lake Worth Road, modifying medians to improve motorist safety, improving signalized intersections and pedestrian crossings, and installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting.

**Cost/Completion:** \$14 million. Completion is expected in winter 2024.

**Traffic Impacts:**

- The outside southbound lane on Military Trail from Bowman Street to Landar Drive may be closed from 7 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, for directional bore installations.
- The outside westbound lane on Lake Worth Road from Congress Avenue to Military Trail may be closed from 7 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, for directional bore installations.
- The outside southbound lane on Kirk Road from north of Lake Worth Road to south of Lake Worth Road may be closed from 7 a.m. until 3:30 p.m., Tuesday through Friday, for directional bore installations.
- Two inside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road from Kirk Road to Davis Road may be closed from 7 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday night through Thursday night, for force main lateral construction.
- Two inside westbound lanes on Lake Worth Road from Davis Road to Kirk Road may be closed from 7 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday night through Thursday night, for force main lateral construction.
- Two outside eastbound lanes on Lake Worth Road from Kirk Road to Davis Road may be closed nightly from 7 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday night through Thursday night, for force main lateral construction.
- Two outside westbound lanes on Lake Worth Road from Davis Road to Kirk Road may be closed from 7 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday night through Thursday night, for force main lateral construction. **7. Southern Boulevard (SR 80) Bridges Replacement Project**



**Description:** This 0.76-mile project includes replacing the existing bascule (draw) bridge and tide relief bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway (ICWW) and Lake Worth Lagoon between the Town of Palm Beach and the City of West Palm Beach. The project limits are between Washington Road in West Palm Beach and State Road A1A/South Ocean Boulevard in Palm Beach. New decorative lighting, pedestrian features, traffic signals, signage and drainage are included.

**Cost/Completion:** \$97 million. Completion is anticipated in summer 2023.

**Traffic Impact:**

- Flagler Drive from Southern Boulevard to Monroe Drive is closed through summer 2023 as it is reconstructed. Access will be maintained for local traffic only. Traffic will be detoured as follows:
  - Traffic going north on Flagler Drive should: Go west on Southern Boulevard to Washington Road; go north on Washington Road to Monroe Drive; go east on Monroe Drive to Flagler Drive.
  - Traffic going south on Flagler Drive should: Go west on Monroe Drive to Washington Road; go south on Washington Road to Southern Boulevard; go east on Southern Boulevard to Flagler Drive.
- **Advance notice:** The Southern Boulevard Bridge between Flagler Drive and west of SR A1A will be closed from 12 a.m. to 4 a.m. Thursday, June 1, to work on mechanical components. Traffic will be detoured to the SR 704/Royal Park Bridge.

**Marine Impact:**

- The navigable waterway through the Southern Boulevard Bridge is restricted to half-channel navigation. During half-channel closures, the horizontal clearance through the bridge is 40 feet.

**8. SR 809/Military Trail at SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard Intersection Improvements Project**

**Description:** This 0.705-mile intersection improvement project on State Road 809/Military Trail and SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard in Palm Beach County began on September 6, 2022. Work includes widening, milling, and resurfacing along SR 809/Military Trail and SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, constructing additional right and left turn lanes on SR 809/Military Trail and additional right turn lanes on SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, installing new 5-foot bike lanes at various locations along SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, improving sidewalks and driveways at the intersection of SR 809/Military Trail and SR 882/Forest Hill Boulevard, installing four new signal mast arms at the intersection, and installing new signage and pavement markings.

**Cost/Completion:** \$7 million. Completion is expected in winter 2024.

**Traffic Impact:**

## 9. SR 710/Beeline Highway Resurfacing and Restoration Project

**Description:** This 1.291 miles resurfacing and restoration project, from east of the Pratt & Whitney Main Entrance to east of the CSX Railroad Tracks in Palm Beach County is anticipated to begin on Monday, February 6, 2023. Project improvements include milling and resurfacing existing travel lanes and shoulders, upgrading pavement markings and signing to current standards, installing internally illuminated street name signs at signalized intersections, and upgrading existing street lighting to Light Emitting Diode (LED) luminaires.

**Cost/Completion:** \$3.2 million/Summer 2023

### **Traffic Impact:**

## 10. SR 80/Southern Boulevard Resurfacing and Bridge Rehabilitation Project

**Description:** This 0.73-mile project in West Palm Beach will begin June 5, 2023. Improvements on Southern Boulevard between east of Parker Avenue and west of Washington Road consist of repaving the roadway and replacing damaged sidewalk. Improvements also include adding new pavement markings and upgrading pedestrian signals, lighting and signage. The bridge rehabilitation includes replacing the bridge deck joints, repairing the concrete traffic railing, and rehabilitating and painting the steel beams over Georgia Avenue.

**Cost/Completion:** \$3.8 million/Fall 2023

## 11. State Road (SR) 704/Royal Park Bridge Painting Project

**Description:** This 0.221-mile project in the City of West Palm Beach and Town of Palm Beach will begin on May 8. It consists of repainting the steel and concrete portions of the Royal Park Bridge over the Intracoastal Waterway.

**Cost/Completion:** \$2,335,538/Spring 2024

### **Traffic Impact:**

- The outside westbound lane on the Royal Park Bridge between Flagler Drive and South Lake Drive will be closed continuously through June 30 for staging of equipment.
- The Okeechobee Boulevard/Royal Park Bridge north sidewalk, from Flagler Drive to South Lake Drive, is closed during construction. Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times via the south sidewalk accessible at Flagler Drive and Coconut Row. **(Riviera Beach, North Palm Beach, Palm Beach Gardens, Juno Beach, Jupiter, Tequesta)**

### **12. SR A1A/Blue Heron Boulevard Bridge Rehabilitation Project**

**Description:** This 0.37-mile project in Riviera Beach began on March 20. Improvements consist of replacing portions of the bridge deck in the outside westbound lane, repairing concrete on the bridge foundations, and cleaning and painting the concrete portions of the bridge. Improvements also include milling and resurfacing the roadway at each end of the bridge and adding new pavement markings.

**Cost/Completion:** \$4,444,623/Late 2023

#### **Traffic Impact:**

- Blue Heron Boulevard's westbound lanes and sidewalk between Lake Shore Drive and west of Lake Drive are closed through August 2023 for deck replacement in the outside westbound lane. Traffic is being diverted to the eastbound lanes with one lane of traffic in each direction. ### **13. Australian Avenue Lighting Improvements Project**

**Description:** This 1.13-mile lighting improvements project, from West 1<sup>st</sup> Street to State Road 708/Blue Heron Boulevard in Palm Beach County began on Monday, November 22, 2021. The City of Riviera Beach, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, design and construct the Australian Avenue Lighting Improvements Project, through application to the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency and City of Riviera Beach Resolution 2020-0987 Work includes installing a continuous decorative LED lighting system, replacing concrete sidewalk and driveways impacted by LED light pole installations and curb and gutter improvements, and upgrading pedestrian curb ramps and pavement markings to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Requirements.

**Cost/Completion:** \$3 million. Completion is expected in summer 2023.
