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### **FDOT Broward County Traffic Impact Report**

*July 11, 2025, through July 18, 2025*

**FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla.** – Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the weeks of July 11, 2025, through July 18, 2025. Weather permitting, work will be done at the following locations throughout the county. Please note, any full road, ramp or bridge closures have been **highlighted** below. #### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS**

##### **INTERSTATES**

- 1. State Road (SR) 9/I-95 from south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard in the City of Hollywood to the south of SR 842/Broward Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale and SR 862/I-595 from SR 9/I-95 to SR 7/US 441 in the Town of Davie (95 Express Phase 3C)**

**Description:** Work on this 9-mile 95 Express project includes extending the 699 existing Express Lanes north from just south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to just south of SR 842/Broward Boulevard in Broward County. One lane will be added, and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of general-use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include the construction of I-95/I-595 Direct Connectors between SR 9/95 Express Lanes and SR 862/I-595, as well as reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and widening of SR 862/I-595 from SR 7/US 441 to SR 9/I-95 and along SR 9/I-95 from south of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of SR 842/Broward Boulevard. Additional work includes bridge widening along SR 9/I-95 at several locations, painting of 17 bridges within project limits, SR 9/I-95/SR 84 interchange modifications, Integrated Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, including cameras, detectors, and dynamic message signs to optimize traffic operations, tolling/gantry construction, ramp signalization implementation at the interchanges, lighting, signage and drainage installation and construction of shoulder-mounted sound walls and retaining walls. **Traffic Patterns:**

- **Traffic Pattern for SR 862/I-595 Westbound to Florida's Turnpike and SR 84 Ramp:** The SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp to SR 91/Florida's Turnpike and SR 84 (Exit 8) and the ramp to US 441/SR 7 (Exit 9A-B) are now permanently separated into two ramps. The newly constructed SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp to SR 91/Florida's Turnpike and SR 84 (Exit 8) is located slightly west of the previous location and is open to drivers. Exit 9A-B continues to serve drivers traveling to US 441/SR 7. Signage is in place to assist motorists.
- **New SR 9/I-95 Northbound Managed Lane Traffic Pattern:** The SR 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes, which currently end at SR 848/Stirling Road, will be extended approximately 5,500 feet to just north of SR 818/Griffin Road by Tuesday morning, July 15. This extension enhances lane continuity and safety. Motorists must exit the managed lanes north of SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to access SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 848/Stirling Road, or SR 818/Griffin Road. Overhead signage has been updated to reflect the new exit pattern: **Local Exits 21-29 & Sheridan St thru Griffin Rd.**
  - To safely accommodate the extension, northbound SR 9/I-95 will have three inside lanes closed from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Sunday night, July 13 and Monday night, July 14, between the SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard managed lanes exit ramp and just north of SR 818/Griffin Road.
  - The northbound SR 9/I-95 managed lanes entrance at SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard will also be closed from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Sunday night, July 13, and Monday night, July 14. Traffic within the SR 9/I-95 northbound managed lanes will exit at the SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard slip ramp and merge onto the general-purpose lanes.
  - Tuesday night, July 15, will be reserved as a contingency night if needed.
  - The Florida Highway Patrol and signage will be on-site to assist motorists. Please view the detour flyer attached.

**Traffic Impacts: Full Closures on SR 9/I-95 and SR 862/I-595 Mainline**

- **Southbound SR 9/I-95 Advanced Full Closure Notice:** All lanes of southbound SR 9/I-95 between SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard and SR 824/ Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Sunday, July 13. This closure is necessary to allow crews to safely install detection loops. The first lane will close at 9:30 p.m., the second lane will close at 10:30 p.m., and all lanes will be closed by 11 p.m., reopening by 5 a.m.
  - Monday, July 20, will be reserved as a contingency night.During the full closure, southbound SR 9/I-95 traffic will be detoured via the exit ramp to eastbound or westbound SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard. Eastbound SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be routed via southbound Dixie Highway and westbound SR 824/Pembroke Road to access the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Westbound SR 820/Hollywood

Boulevard will be routed via southbound US 441/SR 7 and eastbound SR 824/Pembroke Road to access the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. To ensure motorist and crew safety, the ingress to southbound SR 9/I-95 managed lanes at SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed from 9 p.m. until 5 a.m. Motorists may enter the managed lanes at the Miami Gardens ingress. The Florida Highway Patrol (FHP) will be on site to assist with traffic control, and detour signage will be in place to guide motorists safely through the area. #### **SR 9/I-95 Traffic Impacts:**

- SR 9/I-95 in each direction, between SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard and SR 736/Davie Boulevard, may have up to three lanes closed, nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third lane will close at 10:30 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- SR 9/I-95 in each direction, from SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of SR 736/Davie Boulevard, will have shoulder closures, daily and nightly, as needed, Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound managed lanes and the inside general-purpose lane from Ives Dairy Road to SR 822/Sheridan Street may be closed nightly from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving operations. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists.

#### **SR 9/I-95 Ramp Impacts:**

- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from Davie Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday for overhead sign structure installation. Traffic will be detoured via westbound SR 736/Davie Boulevard, northbound Riverland Road, and eastbound SR 842/Broward Boulevard to access the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 736/Davie Boulevard who wish to access the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp will be directed to make a U-turn at the SR 9/I-95 overpass and follow the detour route through Riverland Road. FHP will be on-site, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance from the Broward Boulevard Park and Ride will be closed to traffic nightly as needed from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95 to the westbound SR 862/I-595 ramp, SR 7/US 441, and eastbound SR 862/I-595 to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. FHP will be on-site, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound to SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 818/Griffin Road and SR 7/US 441 to the SR 862/I-595 entrance ramps. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound to the SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for

lighting and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 818/Griffin Road, and SR 7/ US 441 to the SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The SR 9/I-95 southbound to SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via westbound SR 862/I-595, and SR 7/US 441 to the I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound to SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for lighting installation. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound SR 862/I-595, SR 5/US 1, and SR 84 to the SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead structure and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via westbound SR 9/ I-95 southbound, and westbound SR 84 to the SR 862/ I-595 entrance ramps. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, lighting, and island construction operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound,

SR 818/Griffin Road, SR 5/US 1, and SR 848/Stirling Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Motorists traveling westbound SR 848/Stirling Road will be detoured via Anglers Avenue, and SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling eastbound SR 848/Stirling Road will be detoured via SR 5/US 1 and, SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95, SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 7/US 441, and SR 848/Stirling Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 848/Stirling Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 7/US 441 southbound, and eastbound SR 822/Sheridan Street to SR 9/I-95 southbound. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 northbound, SR 848/Stirling Road, and SR 5/US 1. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 822/Sheridan Street, SR 5/US 1, and SR 848/Stirling Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic nightly as needed from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound Dixie Highway and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. As an alternate detour, traffic may be routed via westbound SR 822/Sheridan Street, southbound N Park Road and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 822/Sheridan Street will be closed to traffic nightly as needed from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. for ITS, paving, and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95, SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard and N Park Road to SR 822/Sheridan Street. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS installation and punch list operations. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be detoured via SR 811/North

Dixie Highway and SR 822/Sheridan Street to the SR 9/I-95 entrance ramp. Motorists traveling westbound on SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be detoured via North Park Road and SR 822/Sheridan Street to the SR 9/I-95 entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The SR 9/I-95 northbound exit ramp to SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS installation and punch list operation. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 northbound, eastbound SR 822/Sheridan Street, and N Dixie Highway to SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS installation and punch list operations. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be detoured via SR 811/South Dixie Highway and SR 824/Pembroke Road to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling westbound on SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be detoured via South Park Road and eastbound SR 824/Pembroke Road to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday for ITS installation and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 9/I-95, westbound SR 824/Pembroke Road, and North Park Road to SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving and punch list operations. Motorists traveling eastbound on SR 824/Pembroke Road will be detoured via SR 5/US 1 and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Motorists traveling westbound will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, and SR 820/Hollywood Boulevard to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound exit ramp to SR 824/Pembroke Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, paving and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 858/Hallandale Beach Boulevard, SR 7/US 441, and SR 824/Pembroke Road. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp from SR 862/I-595 westbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 862/I-595 westbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp from SR 862/I-595 eastbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through



Thursday.

- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps to SR 818/Griffin Road may have two lanes closed intermittently, nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound exit ramps to SR 848/Stirling Road may have two lanes closed intermittently, nightly as needed Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 9/I-95 northbound and southbound entrance ramps from SR 848/Stirling Road may have one lane closed intermittently, nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday, for ITS and drilled shaft operations.
- **\*Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per nighttime construction operations; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

#### **SR 862/I-595 Traffic Impacts:**

- SR 862/I-595 in each direction, from east of SR 7/US 441 to Anglers Avenue, may have up to three lanes closed nightly as needed, 9 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. The first lane will close at 9 p.m., the second lane will close at 9:30 p.m., and the third lane will close at 10:30 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- I-595 in each direction, from SR 7/US 441 to SR 9/I-95, will have shoulder closures, daily and nightly as needed, Sunday through Thursday.
- Eastbound SR 862/I-595 between SR 7/US 441 and SR 9/I-95 has been shifted to the inside lanes to allow for widening and bridge construction operations. This pattern is anticipated to be in place through Spring 2025.

#### **SR 862/I-595 Ramp Impacts:**

- The SR 862/I-595 exit ramp to SR 818/Griffin Road will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for ITS, lighting and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound, SR 848/Stirling Road, and Anglers Avenue. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound ramp to SR 9/I-95 southbound will be closed from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting operations and punch list items. Eastbound SR 862/I-595 traffic will be detoured via the SR 862/I-595 ramp to US-1, and SR 818/Griffin Road to access southbound SR 9/I-95. Westbound SR 862/I-595 traffic will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, and SR 818/Griffin Road to access southbound SR 9/I-95. FHP will be on site, and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound to SR 9/I-95 northbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed from 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge painting and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via eastbound SR 862/I-595, SR 5/US 1, and SR 84 to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound to SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. Sunday through

Thursday, for overhead structure and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 9/I-95 southbound, and SR 818/Griffin Road to the SR 9/I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.

- The SR 7/US 441 to I-595 eastbound entrance ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure placement operations. Traffic will be detoured via southbound SR 7/US 441, Griffin Road, and SR 9/I-95 northbound to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound to SR 9/I-95 southbound ramp will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure or roadway operations. Traffic will be detoured via westbound SR 862/I-595, SR 7/US 441, and eastbound SR 862/I-595 to the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp to SR 84 eastbound and the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed 10 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for sign structure installation operations. Motorists will be detoured via the adjacent ramp to SR 84. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound ramp to SR 7/US 441 and the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike will be closed nightly, as needed from 10:30 p.m. until 5:30 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for paving and punch list operations. Traffic will be detoured via SR 862/I-595 westbound and SR 736/Davie Boulevard to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp from SR 7/US 441, the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike, and SR 84 will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday. Motorists will be detoured via SR 7/US 441, SR 818/Griffin Road, and SR 9/I-95. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp from SR 736/Davie Road will be closed to traffic nightly as needed, 10:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for overhead sign structure installation. Traffic will be detoured via SR 7/US 441 northbound, Davie Boulevard eastbound, the SR 9/I-95 southbound entrance ramp to the SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound ramp to southbound US 441/SR 7 and eastbound SR 84 will be closed to traffic from 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. on Sunday, July 13 for overhead sign structure installation. Traffic wishing to access southbound US 441/SR 7 will be detoured via eastbound SR 862/I-595, northbound US 441/SR 7 to U-turn at the US 441/SR 7 and Riverland Road intersection to access southbound US 441/SR 7. Traffic wishing to access eastbound SR 84 will be detoured via northbound US 441/SR 7, eastbound Davie Boulevard, southbound SR 9/I-95, and eastbound SR 82/I-595 to access SR 84. Signage will be in place to assist motorists.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound and westbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 southbound may have two lanes closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.



- The SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 southbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 eastbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 northbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound entrance ramp from SR 9/I-95 northbound may have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- The SR 862/I-595 westbound exit ramp to US 441/SR 7 and the SR 91/Florida's Turnpike will have one lane closed nightly as needed, 9 a.m. until 6 a.m., Sunday through Thursday.
- **\*Please note that ramp closures will be performed as needed per nighttime construction operations; consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.**

#### **SR 84 Traffic Impacts:**

- The SR 84 eastbound entrance ramp from I-595 eastbound, SR 7/US 441, and the SR 91/ Florida's Turnpike will be closed to traffic nightly, as needed, from 10:30 p.m. until 5 a.m., Sunday through Thursday, for bridge construction and painting operations. Traffic will be detoured via the adjacent SR 84 ramp. FHP will be on site and signage will be in place to assist motorists.
