FDOT Broward County Traffic Impact Report

Nov. 21, 2025, through Dec. 5, 2025

FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. – Construction and maintenance-related lane closures on state highways in Broward County are expected during the week of Nov. 21, 2025, through Dec. 5, 2025. Weather permitting, work will be done at the following locations throughout the county. To minimize impact to the public during the Thanksgiving holiday, no lane closures are permitted Thursday, Nov. 27 through Sunday, Nov. 30. 1. State Road (S.R.) 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard in the City of Hollywood to the south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard in the City of Fort Lauderdale and S.R. 862/I-595 from S.R. 9/I-95 to U.S. 441/S.R. 7 in the Town of Davie (95 Express Phase 3C)

Description: Work on this 9-mile 95 Express project includes extending the existing Express Lanes north from just south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to just south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard in Broward County. One lane will be added, and the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lane will be converted to create two Express Lanes in each direction. The number of general-use lanes will remain the same. Other project improvements include the construction of I-95/I-595 Direct Connectors between S.R. 9/95 Express Lanes and S.R. 862/I-595, as well as reconstruction, milling, resurfacing, and widening of S.R. 862/I-595 from U.S. 441/S.R. 7 to S.R. 9/I-95 and along S.R. 9/I-95 from south of S.R. 820/Hollywood Boulevard to south of S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard. Additional work includes bridge widening along S.R. 9/I-95 at several locations, painting of 17 bridges within project limits, S.R. 9/I-95/S.R. 84 interchange modifications, Integrated Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) installation, including cameras, detectors, and dynamic message signs to optimize traffic operations, tolling/gantry construction, ramp signalization implementation at the interchanges. lighting, signage and drainage installation and construction of shoulder-mounted sound walls and retaining walls. Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Traffic Pattern Changes: As part of FDOT's initiative to integrate the southbound Managed Lanes, the following operations will take place to extend and connect two southbound Managed Lanes from State Road (S.R.) 842/Broward Boulevard to S.R. 822/Sheridan Street.

- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will be extended, and tubular markers will be installed from S.R. 842/Broward Boulevard to the South Fork New River Canal Bridge from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Sunday night, Nov. 23, weather permitting. Motorists traveling within the Managed Lanes must exit at the S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard egress to access the S.R. 862/I-595 ramps. The S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard ingress to the Managed Lanes will remain as a designated entrance. Updated overhead signage is in place to reflect the new configuration.
- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will be extended, and tubular markers will be installed from the South Fork New River Canal Bridge to the Dania Cut-Off Canal Bridge, located just north of S.R. 818/Griffin Road, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Monday night, Nov. 24 and Tuesday night, Nov. 25, weather permitting.
 Motorists traveling within the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes system must exit at the S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard egress to access local roads between S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard and S.R. 848/Stirling Road, eastbound S.R. 862/I-595, Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport, and Port Everglades. Updated overhead signage is in place to reflect the new configuration. Dates are subject to change due to weather or unforeseen conditions. Please see the attached graphic for reference.
- Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 to westbound S.R. 862/I-595 Direct Connector Fly
 Over Ramp to Open: The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 to westbound S.R. 862/I-595
 direct-connector flyover ramp is scheduled to open by 6 a.m. on Wednesday,
 Nov. 26, weather permitting. If inclement weather or unforeseen circumstances
 arise, the ramp opening will be rescheduled. Updated overhead signage is in

- Southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes Tubular Marker Extension
 Advanced Notice:
- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will be extended, and tubular markers will be installed from the Dania Cut-Off Canal Bridge to just south of S.R. 818/Griffin Road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday night, Dec. 1, weather permitting.
- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will be extended, and tubular markers will be installed from just south of S.R. 818/Griffin Road to south of S.R. 848/Stirling Road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday night, Dec. 2, weather permitting.
- The southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes will be extended, and tubular markers will be installed from south of S.R. 848/Stirling Road to just south of S.R. 822/Sheridan Street from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Wednesday night, Dec. 3, weather permitting. This activity finalizes the remaining segment of the southbound Managed Lanes connection. During this operation, crews will also integrate the designated southbound Managed Lanes egress at S.R. 848/Stirling Road.

Motorists traveling within the southbound S.R. 9/I-95 Managed Lanes system must exit at the S.R. 816/Oakland Park Boulevard egress to access local roads between S.R. 838/Sunrise Boulevard and S.R. 848/Stirling Road, eastbound S.R. 862/I-595, Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport, and Port Everglades. Updated overhead signage is in place to reflect the new configuration. Dates are subject to change due to weather or unforeseen conditions. Please see the attached graphic for reference.

Motorists traveling within the northbound managed lanes will exit at C.R. 854/Ives Dairy Road onto the General-Purpose lanes. The next available ingress will be at S.R. 848/Stirling Road.
