WIDENING PROJECT
County Road (CR) 512 from east of I-95 to west of 106 Avenue
Indian River County, Florida
Financial Project ID: 449332-1-52-01

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will conduct a public meeting for the above referenced project within Indian River County. This public meeting will be offered in-person and virtually simultaneously. The public meeting will have representatives available to answer questions. Project information will be available for public viewing. Questions and comments may be submitted prior to the meeting by contacting the Project Manager. The presentation will start at 6:00 p.m. followed by a question-and-answer session. Project information is posted at: <https://tinyurl.com/449332-1-CR512Project>.

PURPOSE OF PROJECT: Currently there are three eastbound through lanes west of 108 Avenue and only two receiving lanes east of 108 Avenue. This project will create a third receiving lane for eastbound traffic and provide sufficient distance for vehicles to merge before CR 512 transitions into two eastbound lanes.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen, mill, and resurface eastbound CR 512 to provide a standard merging lane east of the 108 Avenue intersection.
- Reconfigure the pedestrian ramps and crosswalks at 108 Avenue to shorten the distance for pedestrians crossing CR 512, improving safety by reducing the time to cross the intersection.
- Replace the eastbound and southbound signal mast arms at the CR 512 and 108 Avenue intersection impacted by the widening.
- Regrade the eastbound swales and construct new drainage structures as required.
- Increase lighting at the intersection to make pedestrians more visible to drivers, improving safety.
- Upgrade the eastbound signing and pavement marking as required to meet current standards.

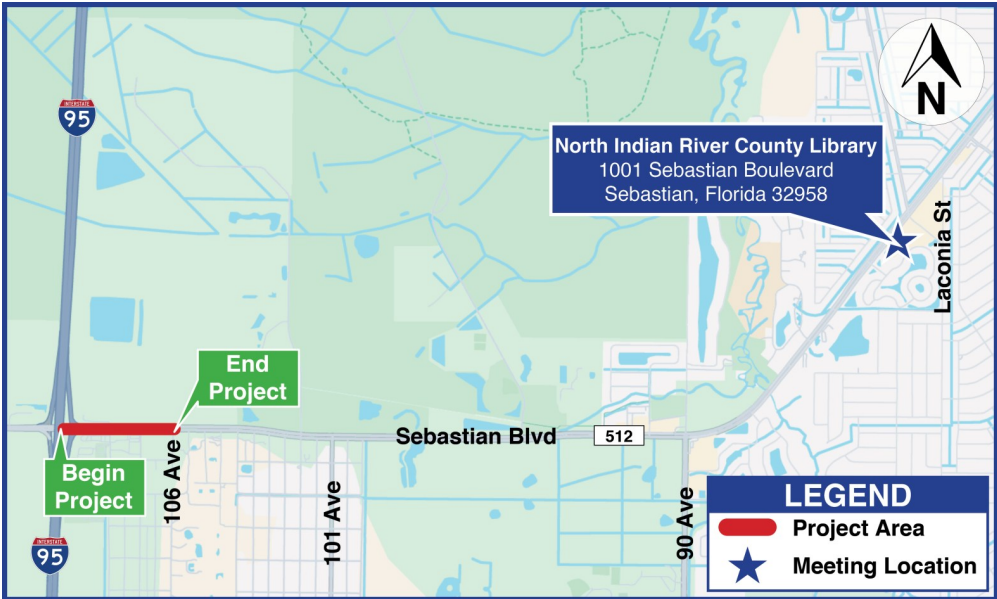
CONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

- Work will be done in phases to reduce the effects of construction on the community.
- Partial vehicular detours will be required to complete the mast arm overhead work at the CR 512 and 108 Avenue intersection.
- Partial pedestrian detours will be required to complete the Pedestrian ramps and crosswalk realignment.
- Access to properties along the corridor will be maintained at all times.
- Another public meeting (Construction Open House) will be held prior to construction. Detailed information about how to keep informed of potential construction impacts will be provided at this meeting.
